REQUESTED ACTION: Approve a resolution establishing temporary speed zone reduction on Northeast 78th Street, from Northeast 13th Avenue to Northeast 25th Avenue, for a Clark Regional Wastewater District sewer replacement project.

Consent Hearing County Manager

BACKGROUND

Clark Regional Wastewater District will replace sewer pipes and laterals under the center of Northeast 78th Street. Traffic will be shifted south to create a work zone for construction crews in the center of the road resulting in one westbound travel lane and two eastbound travel lanes. A reduced speed limit will help provide a safer working environment for workers and drivers.

The speed limit on this section of Northeast 78th Street will be reduced from 35 mph to 25 mph.

The temporary speed reduction will begin on March 1, 2018, or the start of construction, whichever is later, and end on Sept. 30, 2018, or the completion of construction, whichever is earlier.



RESOLUTION NO. 2018-02-11

A RESOLUTION to install a temporary 25 MPH zone on Northeast 78th Street, from Northeast 13th Avenue to Northeast 25th Avenue, for a Clark Regional Wastewater District sewer replacement project.

1 **WHEREAS**, the Clark County Council has legislative jurisdiction over specific traffic
2 operations, including designated roadway or specific lanes which vehicular traffic can and
3 cannot proceed; and

4 **WHEREAS**, establishment of the speed reduction is deemed advisable and in the best
5 interest of safety of the traveling public; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Clark County Council has determined that adoption of this resolution
7 for a temporary speed zone provides a general public benefit and will sunset upon completion of
8 the Clark Regional Wastewater District sewer replacement project but no later than the sunset
9 date, now therefore,

10 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED** by the County Council of Clark
11 County, State of Washington, that the following road be established with the following speed
12 limits temporarily:

13 A speed of 25 MPH on Northeast 78th Street from Northeast 13th Avenue to Northeast
14 25th Avenue. The modified speed limit will be in effect until the end of road construction, but no
15 later than the 31st day of September, 2018.

16 **AND**,

17 **The Washington State Patrol** is requested to enforce the provisions of this resolution.

18 **The Sheriff of Clark County** is directed to enforce the provisions of this resolution.

19 **The Director of Public Works** is directed to erect and maintain the necessary signs in
20 accordance with the Uniform Standards adopted by the Washington State Secretary of

21 Transportation at both ends of Northeast 78th Street with the modified speed limit.




