

**AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT AND
PROSECUTION BETWEEN CLARK COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AND THE
COWLITZ INDIAN TRIBE**

This Amendment is made and entered into by and between the Clark County, Washington (“County”), a political subdivision of the State of Washington, and the Cowlitz Indian Tribe (“Tribe”), a federally-recognized Indian Tribe (collectively referred to as the “Parties”).

WHEREAS, the Parties executed An Agreement for Law Enforcement and Prosecution (“Agreement”) on April 18, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement remains in effect for one (1) from the date of execution and provides that the Agreement may be extended for one (1) year upon mutual written agreement of the Parties; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of efficiency and continuity of services;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED BETWEEN THE PARTIES:

- a. In recognition of the above, the Tribe and County agree that the term of the Agreement is hereby extended for one (1) year term commencing on April 19, 2018.
- b. All remaining terms and conditions of the Agreement are hereby ratified and confirmed.




