While Community Planning Department's Annual Report includes a one page update on the BPAC each year, the BPAC would like to provide an overview of the Clark County Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan and discuss their 2018 work program that implements the Clark County Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan.
5. **DESIRED RESULTS:** This is an opportunity for the council to receive an update from the BPAC on their activities to date and ask questions of the BPAC.
6. **IMPACTS (COMMUNITY/FINANCIAL/STAFF/OTHER):** It has been many years since the committee has provided an update to the council during a work session.
7. **POLICY IMPLICATIONS:** There are no policy implications.
8. **ISSUES TO BE CONSIDERED:** In 2010, Clark County adopted the Clark County Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan was. An implementation strategy is to update the plan a minimum of every five years as necessary. The plan is eight (8) years old. Demographics in Clark County are changing. Our population is growing, aging and becoming more diversified. BPAC recognizes the need to reevaluate the plan, measure the plan's performance and achievements over time, and redesign the critical prioritization criteria included in the plan to emphasize equity outcomes and improve the plan's implementation countywide.
9. **RECOMMENDED ACTION:** This is an informational session only and an opportunity for the council to ask questions of the BPAC.
