BACKGROUND

As required by RCW 84.34.037, Current Use Assessment requests are processed in the same manner as Comprehensive Plan Amendments. All requests for "Open Space" designations require Planning Commission review and recommendation to the Clark County Council. If approved, the requests will become effective in September 2018 for the 2019 tax statements.

This year, Public Works received five applications for Current Use under the Open Space Soil Conservation, Stream Protection and Historic Sites designations. Staff reviewed the requests and determined they meet the criteria outlined in Clark County Code, Chapter 3.08, Open Space Taxation.

The Planning Commission reviewed the applications during a work session on March 1, 2018, and a public hearing on March 15, 2018. The commission unanimously recommended approval of each of the five applications.

This action does not propose a new policy, change in policy, or refinement of an existing policy. The action does confirm an existing policy. This is the 30th year the county has reviewed Current Use Assessment applications.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approval of five applications for Current Use Assessment in the Open Space Soil Conservation, Stream Protection, & Historic Site

designations.

INTRODUCTION

The Department of Public Works has reviewed the Current Use Assessment requests accepted during 2017, and has proposed that the Planning Commission forward the request to the Clark County Councilors for consideration and approval. The Planning Commission, in a duly noticed public hearing held March 15 2018, voted to recommend that the Clark County Councilors approve the request.

If approved, the request will become effective during September 2018 for the 2019 calendar year tax statements. As required by Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 84.34.037, Current Use Assessment requests are processed in the same manner as Comprehensive Plan Amendments. These requests are usually evaluated after receiving the applications late in the calendar year preceding the year of tax assessment to be under Current Use.

All requests for Current Use classification require Planning Commission review, and are also considered by the Clark County Councilors. This is the 31st year the county has reviewed Current Use Assessment applications. The Open Space criteria vary according to the category requested.

These applications have requested the Soil Conservation designation, Stream Protection, and Historic Sites designation. According to Chapters 3.08 (.040), (.050), (.060) of the Clark County Code, Soil Conservation of more than the required 10 acres of class I or class II soil types and greater than 80% of the property is in food or fiber production; for Stream Protection tracts contiguous to or straddling major streams designated shorelines of the state, or identified in the county's shoreline master program; for Historic Sites of preservation of historic sites will be limited to historic sites

and land containing structures of historic significance so long as they are listed on the local, state or national historic registers and protected as such; These applications have been evaluated in light of these criteria.

BACKGROUND

Current Use Application# 2017-00003: Tudor, LLC.

The applicant has requested that 2.79 acres of the 2.79 acres in Tideland Tax Lot No. 500101-000 in Section 01, Township 04 North, Range 01 West, of the Willamette Meridian, including Parcel # 500101-000 be classified as Open Space Stream Protection.

The site is located on portion of the BNSF Railway Company Second Class Tidelands in a portion of Government Lot 5 and Government Lot 6 along the south bank of the Lewis River. An on-site review indicated that the area applied for is within the Shoreline Management Zone of the Lewis River. The acreage is contiguous with the same ownership already in the program. The application meets all criteria for Open Space Stream Protection as specified in Chapter 3.08.040 of the Clark County Code. Therefore, staff recommends **APPROVAL** of the application.

Current Use Application #2017-00004: Kromminga Family

The applicant has requested that 80.97 acres of the 80.97 acres in Tax Lots #1 Samuel R Whipple DLC, 19; parcel #s 190860-000, 180286-000 be transferred from a Farm & Agriculture classification to Open Space Soil Conservation and Stream Protection.

The site is located west of NW Krieger Road and South of NW 192ND Street, south west of Ridgefield. An on-site review indicated that the area applied for contains a class I soil type of Hillsboro Silt Loam (HoA) greater than 10 acres in area at least 80% of the property is in food and fiber production. The area is also within the Shoreline Management Zone of the Whipple Creek. The application meets all criteria for Open Space Soil Conservation and Stream Protection as specified in Chapter 3.08 (.040) and (.050) of the Clark County Code. Therefore, staff recommends **APPROVAL** of the 80.97 acres.

Current Use Application #2017-00005: Hunter Project

The applicant has requested that 14.32 acres of the 14.32 acres in parcel # 196660-000 be classified as Open Space Historic Preservation and Stream Protection.

The site is located at 15716 NE 112TH Ave, in Brush Prairie 98606. An on-site review indicated that there are two historic buildings on site. The Bertha "Bertie" Fifeld House, built in circa 1910, and the The Kapus Granary, built in 1929, are listed on the Clark County Heritage Register. The area is also within the Shoreline Management Zone of the Salmon Creek. The application meets all criteria for Open Space Historic Preservation and Stream Protection as specified in Chapter 3.08 (.060) and (.040) of the Clark County Code. Therefore, staff recommends **APPROVAL** of the 14.32 acres.

Current Use Application # 2017-00006: Paula Parnell-Davis

The applicant has requested that 24.63 acres of the 24.63 acres in parcel # 212116-000 be classified Open Space Stream Protection.

The site is located south of NE Stoughton Road. An on-site review indicated that the area applied for is within the Shoreline Management Zone of Mason Creek and the East Fork Lewis River. The application meets all criteria for Open Space Stream Protection as specified in Chapter 3.08.040 of the Clark County Code. Therefore, staff recommends **APPROVAL** of the 24.63 acres.

Current Use Application # 2017-00007: Sharleen James

The applicant has requested that 79 acres of the 80 acres in Tax lots No. 4 and 7 in Section 23 and 24, Township 01 North, Range 04 East, of the Willamette Meridian, including Parcel #s 135508-000, 135819-000, 501100-000 be classified as Open Space Soil Conservation and Stream Protection.

The site is located south of SE Evergreen Hwy at 39315 SE Evergreen Hwy, Washougal, 98671 East of Washougal. An on-site review indicated that the area applied for contains class II soil types Sauvie Silt Loam (SnA) and Newberg Silt Loam (NbA & NbB) greater than 10 acres in area, and at least 80% of the property is in food and fiber production. The area is also within the Shoreline Management Zone of the Columbia River. The application meets all criteria for Open Space Soil Conservation and Stream Protection as specified in Chapter 3.08 (.040) and (.050) of the Clark County Code. Therefore, staff recommends **APPROVAL** of the 79 acres.

PROPOSED ACTION

The applications meet their criteria for Open Space Soil Conservation, Stream Protection, and Historic Sites as specified in Chapter 3.08 (.040), (.050), (.060) of the Clark County Code. Therefore, staff recommended approval of these applications.

PUBLIC OUTREACH

On March 1, 2018 staff met with the Planning Commission to hold a work session regarding the 2017-2018 Current Use application.

On March 15, 2018 staff presented five applications for Current Use, Open Space Soil Conservation, by Martin & Cherie Nye, Open Space Stream Protection at the Planning Commission public hearing.

Information presented to the Planning Commission was also available on the Planning Commission website.

RECOMMENDATION AND CONCLUSIONS

The Planning Commission voted unanimously on each application **5-0** to forward the applications to the Clark County Councilors with a recommendation that the Clark County Councilors approve the applications. Planning Commission unanimously recommended approval of the applications to the Clark
