## **BACKGROUND**

In the 2017 Spring Supplemental Budget, General Services Facilities was approved for a package to do exterior sealing and painting at the Franklin Center (GEN-04). This project was bid and came in with-in the existing budget of \$100,200. As the work proceed on this project it was found that the cornice on the west and north sides of the building is in very bad condition and could come off the side of the building at any time and fall to the sidewalk below. This staff report is asking for an additional \$46,094 in funding to complete the work. This money will be used to provide all materials and equipment to remove the failing metal cornice at the parapet wall, install scaffolding around the project, haul away and dispose of the debris, protect the sidewalks below, install a new 24-gage copper cover at the site of the previous cornice, and remove and cap a non-functional chimney. If this work is not completed it will be a safety hazard for those on the sidewalks below the building and will continue to weaken the integrity of the building's brickwork as the cornice continues to deteriorate.

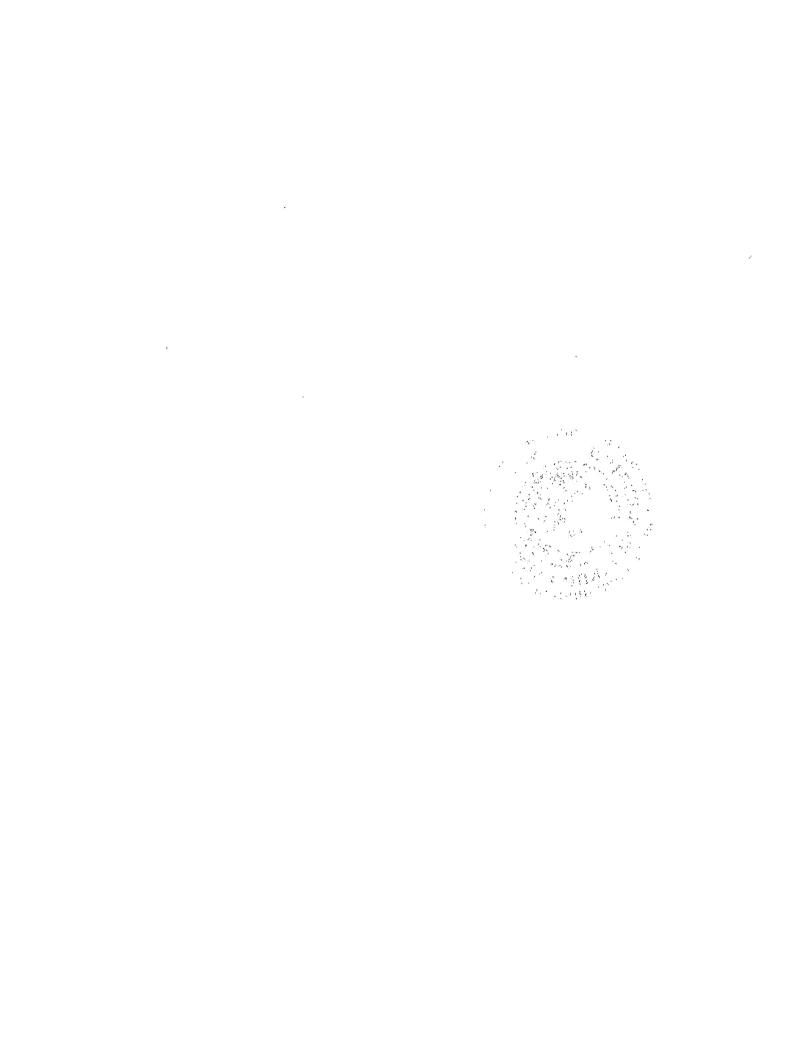
