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BACKGROUND

In the early 2000's the county signed an agreement with Veterans Affairs (VA) to build the Center for Community Health (CCH) on the VA Vancouver property. In the Extend Use Lease (EUL) it was agreed that if the VA, who are housed in the building, needed tenant improvements the county would complete those improvements and bill back the VA for 100% of the cost. The VA has requested tenant improvements on the 4th floor of CCH in the Alaska Room that will cost \$238,600 for the remodel work and \$20,700 for the architectural services. The remodel portion of the project will go through the Counties competitive bid process.
