REQUESTED ACTION: Approve the attached Notice to Contractors to advertise the contract for bids and authorize traffic restrictions for NE 119th Street East (NE 87th Avenue - NE 112th Avenue) Project #: 342422.

Consent Hearing County Manager

BACKGROUND

This project will improve this section of Northeast 119th Street, from Northeast 87th Avenue to Northeast 112th Avenue, to a four-lane minor arterial with center turn lane and median, bicycle lanes and sidewalks. Utility work and stormwater mitigation will be included in this project.

This project will be the latest in a series on the Northeast 119th Street corridor and improves a section between two completed projects. The project is expected to take two construction seasons to build, with completion in fall 2019. For the safety of construction workers and drivers, the speed limit in the construction area will be reduced to 25 mph.

During summer 2018, the contractor will be permitted to close a section of Northeast 119th Street, from Northeast 99th Street to Northeast 102nd Avenue, to all traffic for up to 14 consecutive calendar days. This maximum 14-day closure will happen during an approximately eight-week period, beginning on Monday, July 2, 2018, and ending on Friday, Aug. 25, 2018. The contractor also will be allowed to close this section of Northeast 119th Street for three consecutive weekends.

Variable message signs will notify the public for five days prior to and five days after the traffic restrictions. Specific traffic restriction dates and detour information will be provided to the public in accordance with RCW 47.48.020 Notice of Closure or Restriction and posted on the county website. A Heads Up mailer will be sent out approximately one month before construction begins to notify residents and property owners in and near the construction zone of the upcoming work.

Construction documents are complete. Public Works will advertise the contract for bids upon funding approval from WSDOT Highways and Local Programs. The advertisement is contained in the attached Notice to Contractors.

COUNCIL POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. This project supports the council's policy of investing in the county road system and providing safe and efficient transportation systems for all county residents.

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. The project is included in the 2018-2023 Transportation Improvement Program, 2018 Annual Construction Program (No. 4) and the 2017/2018 Biennium Budget.



IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT NE 119th Street East

lying along NE 119th Street (NE 87th Avenue to NE 112th Avenue), State Road Log No. 94100 from Milepoint 2.84 to Milepoint 4.17 will be improved as follows:

The project will re-construct an approximately 1.33 mile long section of NE 119th Street between NE 87th Avenue and NE 112th Avenue from a two lane rural road to a standard four lane road with center turn lane, sidewalks, bike lanes, stormwater collection/treatment, and environmental mitigation/improvements. Utilities will be installed and/or improved. Work in and around the existing rail line (Milepost 3.39 and Milepost 3.57), will require a road closure detailed below.

For the safety of workers and the traveling public, Clark County will close NE 119th Street, between NE 99th Avenue and NE 102nd Avenue, to all traffic for up to 14 consecutive calendar days, from July 2, 2018 to August 25, 2018. The contractor will also be permitted up to three consecutive weekend closures. Variable message signs will notify the public for five days prior to and five days after the traffic restrictions. The speed limit in the construction area also will be reduced to 25 miles per hour. A neighborhood mailer will be sent out before construction begins to notify residents and property owners in and near the construction area. Specific traffic restriction dates and detour information will be provided to the public in accordance to RCW 47.48.020 Notice of Closure or Restriction.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT NE 119th Street East

lying along NE 119th Street (NE 87th Avenue to NE 112th Avenue), State Road Log No. 94100 from Milepoint 2.84 to Milepoint 4.17 will be improved as follows:

The project will re-construct an approximately 1.33 mile long section of NE 119th Street between NE 87th Avenue and NE 112th Avenue from a two lane rural road to a standard four lane road with center turn lane, sidewalks, bike lanes, stormwater collection/treatment, and environmental mitigation/improvements. Utilities will be installed and/or improved. Work in and around the existing rail line (Milepost 3.39 and Milepost 3.57), will require a road closure detailed below.

For the safety of workers and the traveling public, Clark County will close NE 119th Street, between NE 99th Avenue and NE 102nd Avenue, to all traffic for up to 14 consecutive calendar days, from July 2, 2018 to August 25, 2018. The contractor will also be permitted up to three consecutive weekend closures. Variable message signs will notify the public for five days prior to and five days after the traffic restrictions. The speed limit in the construction area also will be reduced to 25 miles per hour. A neighborhood mailer will be sent out before construction begins to notify residents and property owners in and near the construction area. Specific traffic restriction dates and detour information will be provided to the public in accordance to RCW 47.48.020 Notice of Closure or Restriction.



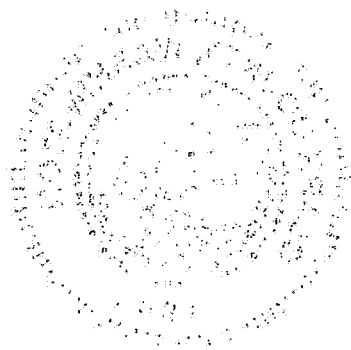

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by Clark County, Washington until **1:50 P.M.** on _____ for: **CRP No. or WO No. 342422, NE 119th Street East.**

Sealed bids shall be delivered to the office of Clark County Purchasing, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660 (or P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, WA 98666-5000). Bids delivered to locations other than as indicated above or received after the time indicated above will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, on the same day in the Hearing Room of the Board of County Councilors, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center.

Description of work: This project is to widen the roadway two-lanes to the standards of a four-lane minor arterial (M-4cb) which includes; center left-turn lanes, sidewalks, and bike lanes. Water lines, sewer lines installation, railroad crossing signal

Primary bid items: ex. Roadway Excavation (Incl. Haul); Crushed Surfacing Base Course; HMA Cl., PG 64-22; Stormwater, Sewer, and Water Main Pipe; Manholes; Conc. Pervious Sidewalk, Traffic Curb and Gutter; Traffic Control; Pavement Striping; Guardrail; Bioretention, Driveways, Interconnect, Illumination System, Rail Crossing Signal.

Bid documents can be viewed, downloaded, or purchased on the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) website www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Bidders are encouraged to "Register as a Bidder" in order to receive automatic email notification of future addenda and to be placed on the Bidders List. Electronic and paper copies of bid documents are not available from Clark County.

It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to obtain Addenda, if any. Such information may be obtained from the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) web site, www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Clark County accepts no responsibility or liability and will provide no accommodation to bidders who fail to check for addenda and submit inadequate or incomplete bids.

Questions and requests for clarification must be submitted using the electronic "CRP Inquiry Submittal Form" located on the County website, <https://www.clark.wa.gov/general-services/public-works-roads-parks-clean-water-projects>. Responses will be posted on the project's "Bid Inquiry Log".

All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid documents. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the Bidder's company name, project title, project number, bid opening date, and "SEALED BID" clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.

Each bid proposal must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or proposal bond in an amount of at least five percent (5%) of the total bid. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into a contract and furnish a satisfactory contract bond, the bid deposit shall be forfeited to Clark County.

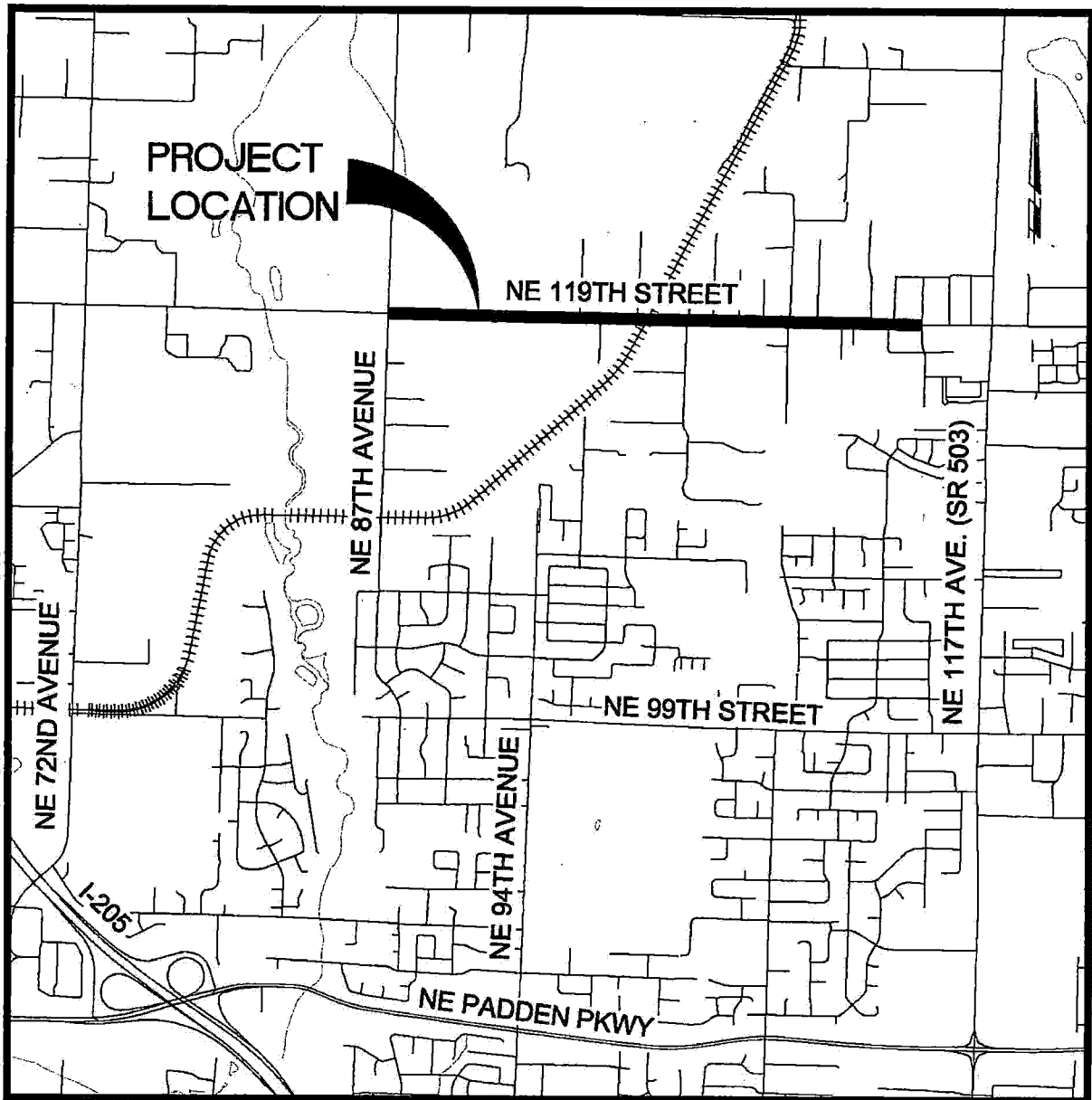
