BACKGROUND

Clark County owns property (Tax Parcel No. 300011-000) along the Chelatchie Prairie Railroad in Yacolt. The Battle Ground, Yacolt, and Chelatchie Prairie Railroad Association (BYCX), which operates a passenger excursion train from May through December, leases the property from the county and maintains the track along this portion of the 33-mile short line.

BYCX wants to construct a maintenance building on the property, which will be owned by the county once constructed. BYCX needs to secure access to utilities before construction can begin. Approving this utility easement with Clark Public Utilities will allow this project to proceed.

The GRANTOR, CLARK COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Washington, for and in consideration of mutual benefits hereby acknowledged, does grant and convey to PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF CLARK COUNTY, a municipal corporation of the State of Washington, GRANTEE, its successors and assigns, including joint users, a non-exclusive, perpetual easement twenty (20) feet in width, together with the right of ingress and egress for the purpose of installing, constructing, erecting, altering, repairing, maintaining and operating thereon and therein an electric system, facilities and appurtenances including communication and service conductors with surface-mounted transformer(s), pole(s), anchor(s), and appurtenances necessary thereto, together with the right and easement to tap into said facilities to serve adjacent and/or adjoining lands, in, on, over, under and across the lands in Clark County, Washington, described as follows:

A portion of Tax lot 11 in the SW 1/4 of Section 35, Township 5 North, Range 3 East of the Willamette Meridian, APN 300011-000 and more particularly described and shown on the attached Exhibits, by this reference made a part hereof.

Upon completion of installation of all facilities, THE EASEMENT HEREIN GRANTED SHALL BE CENTERED ON AND LIMITED TO THE LOCATION OF THE FACILITIES AS PLACED WITH REASONABLE RIGHTS OF INGRESS AND EGRESS FOR THE PURPOSES ABOVE STATED.

The Grantor also covenants to and with the Grantee that Grantor has the right and power to convey an Easement over the tract of land described herein.




