REQUESTED ACTION: Approve the Notice to Contractors to advertise for bids to build the Highway 99 – Kline Sidewalk (NE 122nd Street – NE 129th Street), Project # 370122.

Consent Hearing County Manager

BACKGROUND

This project will construct approximately 1,450 feet of missing sidewalk on the east side of Highway 99 to create a continuous sidewalk, from Northeast 117th Street to Northeast 129th Street.

For the safety of workers and the traveling public, Clark County will reduce the speed limit in the construction area to 30 miles per hour, during construction only.

Construction is scheduled for fall 2018 through early winter 2020. After completion of the sidewalk, ADA ramps, driveways and bicycle lane, the last year of the project is the landscaping and plant establishment stage.

COUNCIL POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. This project supports the council's policy of investing in a safe, efficient, multimodal transportation system for all county residents.

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. This project was included in the adopted 2018-2023 Transportation Improvement Program, the 2018 Annual Construction Program (No. 22) and the adopted 2018-2019 biennium budget.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

This project is included in the 2018-2023 Transportation Improvement Program and 2018 Annual Construction Program. Community outreach for the Transportation Improvement Program included work sessions and a hearing with the Clark County Council, presentations to the Clark County Planning Commission, the Regional Transportation Advisory Committee and the Development and Engineering Advisory Board, as well as a State Environmental Policy Act review and targeted outreach to neighborhood groups and other stakeholders.

In May 2018, Clark County sent a pre-construction "Heads Up" mailer for this project to residents and property owners in the area. A Heads Up mailer will be sent out approximately one month before construction begins, to notify the surrounding public of the project. Specific traffic restriction dates will be provided to the public in accordance to RCW 47.48.020 Notice of Closure or Restriction.



A Resolution to install a temporary 30 MPH zone on Northeast Highway 99 from Northeast 122nd Street to Northeast 129th Street, for the Highway 99-Klineline Sidewalk Project, CRP #370122.

1 **WHEREAS**, the Clark County Council has legislative authority over specific traffic
2 operations, including designated roadway or specific lanes which vehicular traffic can and
3 cannot proceed;

4 **WHEREAS**, establishment of the attached control is deemed advisable and in the best
5 interest of safety of the traveling public; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Clark County Council has determined that adoption of this resolution
7 for a temporary speed zone provides a general public benefit and will sunset upon completion of
8 the Highway 99-Klineline Sidewalk (NE 122nd Street – NE 129th Street) Project, NOW

13 129th Street will be in effect until the end of road construction.
- 14 2. The Washington State Patrol is requested to enforce the provisions of this resolution.
- 15 3. The Sheriff of Clark County is directed to enforce the provisions of this resolution.



Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by Clark County, Washington until 1:50 P.M. on **October 16, 2018** for: **CRP No. 370122, Highway 99-Klineline Sidewalk.**

Sealed bids shall be delivered to the office of Clark County Purchasing, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660 (or P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, WA 98666-5000). Bids delivered to locations other than as indicated above or received after the time indicated above will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, on the same day in the Hearing Room of the Board of County Councilors, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center.

Description of work: This project will be construct approximately 1,450 feet of concrete sidewalk along the east side of Highway 99, between existing improvements at the Klineline Bridge and NE 129th Street. It also includes streetscape amenities such as; seating, decorative pavement accents, and landscaping.

Primary bid items: Roadway Excavation (Incl. Haul); Crushed Surfacing Base Course; Commercial HMA; Conc. Sidewalk, Conc. Pervious Sidewalk; Traffic Control; Driveways, Structural earth walls, Landscaping plantings.

Bid documents can be viewed, downloaded, or purchased on the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) website www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Bidders are encouraged to "Register as a Bidder" in order to receive automatic email notification of future addenda and to be placed on the Bidders List. Electronic and paper copies of bid documents are not available from Clark County.

It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to obtain Addenda, if any. Such information may be obtained from the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) web site, www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Clark County accepts no responsibility or liability and will provide no accommodation to bidders who fail to check for addenda and submit inadequate or incomplete bids.

Questions and requests for clarification must be submitted using the electronic "CRP Inquiry Submittal Form" located on the County website, <https://www.clark.wa.gov/general-services/public-works-roads-parks-clean-water-projects>. Responses will be posted on the project's "Bid Inquiry Log".

All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid documents. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the Bidder's company name, project title, project number, bid opening date, and "SEALED BID" clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.

Each bid proposal must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or proposal bond in an amount of at least five percent (5%) of the total bid. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into a contract and furnish a satisfactory contract bond, the bid deposit shall be forfeited to Clark County.

The Clark County Department of Public Works, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, non-discrimination in federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises as defined at 49 CFR Part 26 will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, national origin, or sex in consideration for an award.

The County reserves the right to waive informalities in the bidding, reject any or all bids, or cancel the bid if the best interests of Clark County are not served.

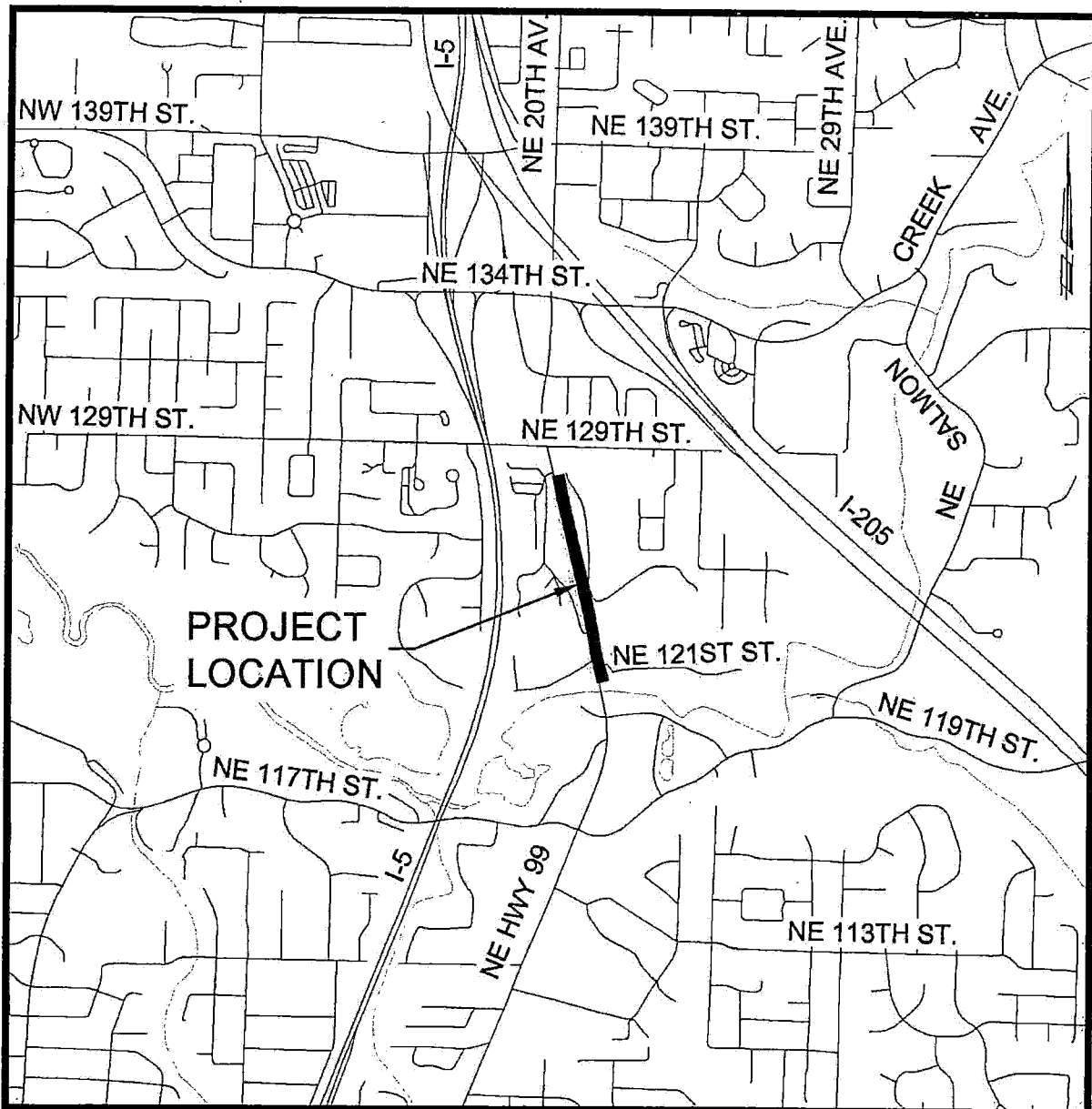
