- WHEREAS, Clark County is a patriotic community that celebrates our history and heritage each Veterans Day; and
- WHEREAS, more than 30 years ago, a committee of volunteers recognized the need to honor all veterans for their service to our country and collaborated with Vancouver and the U.S. Army at Vancouver Barracks to organize the first Veterans Parade at Fort Vancouver; and
- WHEREAS, the community expresses great appreciation to The Historic Trust for organizing the Veterans Parade at Fort Vancouver in partnership with many service organizations and support of sponsors such as Comcast, The Columbian, The Vancouver Clinic, Creekside Mortgage, the Community Military Appreciation Association and the Lough Legacy, an endowment by Frank and Joanne Lough to ensure the Veterans Parade in perpetuity; and
- WHEREAS, more than 125 units with 2,700 people march in the parade each year; and







