REQUESTED ACTION: Approve Notice to Contractors to advertise for bids to build the 2019 Preservation ADA Ramp Improvements (Group 3)
Project #: 371622

Consent Hearing County Manager

BACKGROUND

The 2019 Preservation ADA Ramp Improvements project will construct or upgrade sidewalk curb ramps to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act regulations prior to pavement preservation work. This annual work is bid in multiple groups due to the large number of locations involved.

Group 3 includes 39 ramps at 19 locations:

• NE 81st Court	• NE 83rd Court/NE 91st Street
• NE 81st Avenue/NE 93rd Street	• NE 83rd Court/NE 95th Street
• NE 81st Avenue/NE 94th Street	• NE 83rd Court/NE 96th Street
• NE 81st Avenue/NE 96th Street	• NE 91st Avenue
• NE 82nd Avenue/NE 91st Street	• NE 91st Avenue/NE 70th Circle
• NE 82nd Avenue/NE 92nd Circle	• NE 91st Avenue/NE 68th Street
• NE 82nd Avenue/NE 94th Street	• NE 92nd Court/NE 68th Street
• NE 82nd Avenue/NE 95th Street	• NE 93rd Court/NE 68th Street
• NE 82nd Avenue/NE 96th Street	• NE 94th Avenue/NE 68th Street

In addition, there are nine detectable warning surface retrofits at four additional locations.

Construction documents are complete. Council approval of the attached Notice to Contractors is needed to authorize bid advertisement for this project.

This project supports the council's policy of investing in a safe, efficient, multimodal transportation system for all county residents.

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY IMPLICATIONS

This project was included in the adopted 2018-2023 Transportation Improvement Program, the 2018 Annual Construction Program (No. 22) and the adopted 2018-2019 biennium budget.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

This project is included in the 2018-2023 Transportation Improvement Program and 2018 Annual Construction Program. Community outreach for the Transportation Improvement Program included work sessions and a hearing with the Clark County Council, presentations to the Clark County Planning Commission, the Regional Transportation Advisory Committee and the Development and

Engineering Advisory Board, as well as a State Environmental Policy Act review and targeted outreach to neighborhood groups and other stakeholders.

In August 2017, Clark County sent an initial notification before starting survey work to residents and property owners in the area. Letters also will be sent to property owners who may have landscaping or other items in the county right of way that is needed for construction.

Public Works also developed a one-page handout explaining why the county builds or reconstructs ADA sidewalk ramps on street corners prior to some preservation projects. That handout is posted on the county's website and will be used in community notification and outreach as needed.

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by Clark County, Washington until **1:50 P.M. on October 30, 2018** for: **CRP No. 371622, 2019 Preservation ADA Ramp Improvements (Group 3)**.

Sealed bids shall be delivered to the office of Clark County Purchasing, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660 (or P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, WA 98666-5000). Bids delivered to locations other than as indicated above or received after the time indicated above will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, on the same day in the Hearing Room of the Board of County Councilors, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center.

Description of work: Improve sidewalks and ADA ramps, including curb and pavement restoration, and detectable warning surface retrofits, at various locations in Clark County.

Primary bid items: Construction Surveying; Crushed Surfacing Base Course; HMA Cl. 1/2 In. PG 64-22; Cement Conc. Traffic Curb and Gutter; Cement Conc. Pedestrian Curb; Cement Conc. Sidewalk; Cement Conc. Curb Ramp

Bid documents can be viewed, downloaded, or purchased on the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) website www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Bidders are encouraged to "Register as a Bidder" in order to receive automatic email notification of future addenda and to be placed on the Bidders List. Electronic and paper copies of bid documents are not available from Clark County.

It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to obtain Addenda, if any. Such information may be obtained from the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) web site, www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Clark County accepts no responsibility or liability and will provide no accommodation to bidders who fail to check for addenda and submit inadequate or incomplete bids.

Questions and requests for clarification must be submitted using the electronic "CRP Inquiry Submittal Form" located on the County website, <https://www.clark.wa.gov/general-services/public-works-roads-parks-clean-water-projects>. Responses will be posted on the project's "Bid Inquiry Log".

All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid documents. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the Bidder's company name, project title, project number, bid opening date, and "SEALED BID" clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.

Each bid proposal must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or proposal bond in an amount of at least five percent (5%) of the total bid. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into a contract and furnish a satisfactory contract bond, the bid deposit shall be forfeited to Clark County.



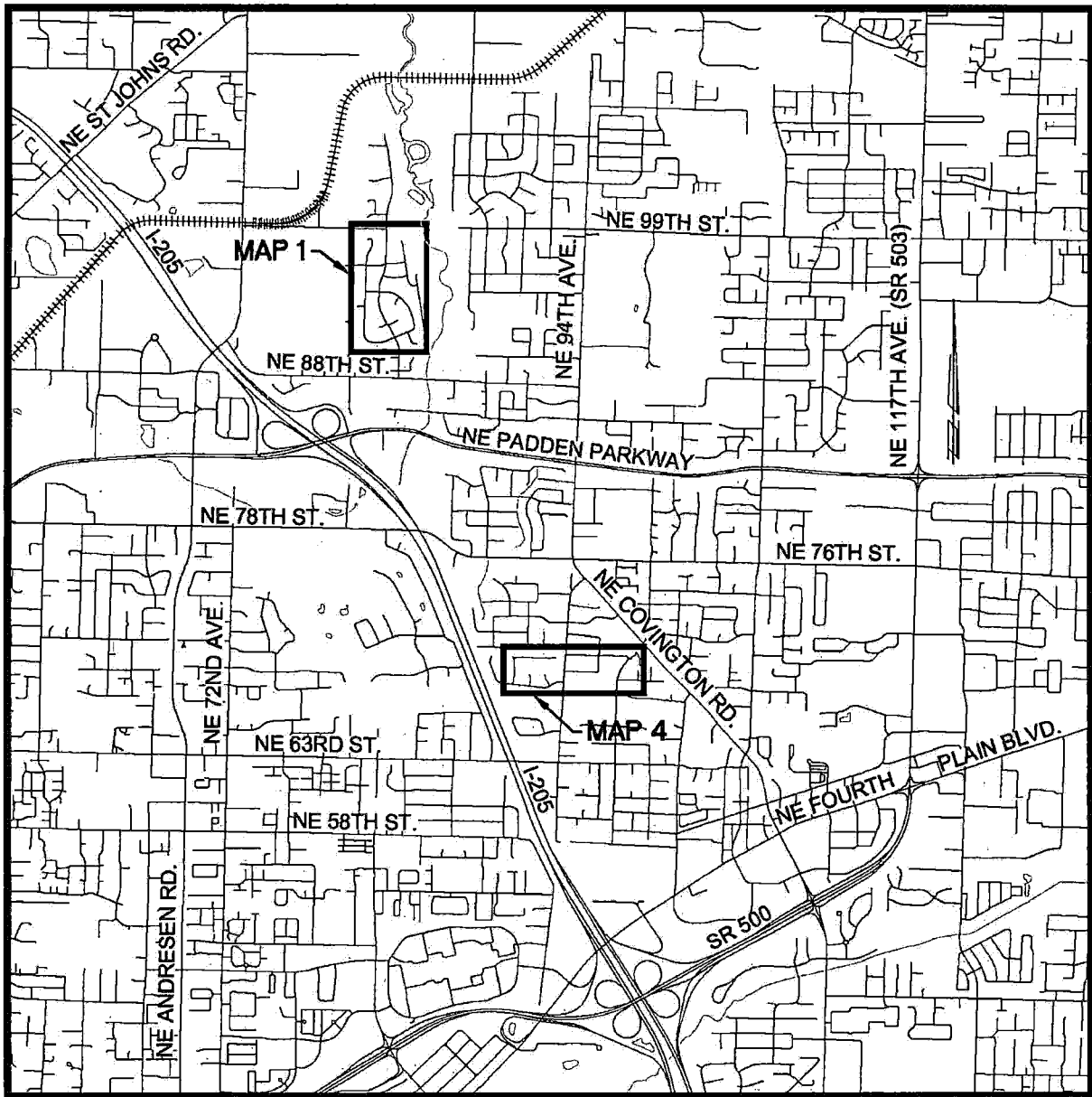
