## BACKGROUND

Transmitted for acceptance by the County Manager is the plat for Tenny Creek Subdivision Phase 1 PLD2018-00007/ FLD2018-00032

Project review: The application vested on October 30, 2017. A pre-application conference was held November 21, 2017. Preliminary approval was issued on June 26, 2018.

Zoning: R-30 with Highway 99 Overlay; Lot Size: The R-30 zone requires a density range between 18 and 30 units per acre. Actual Lot Size: One lot is 8,398 square feet; the other is 10,957 square feet.

The two lots in this proposed first phase do not meet the minimum density required in the R-30 zone; however, the overall development (including the future Phase 2) will meet the density range requirements of the R-30 zone. To ensure the second phase contains a sufficient number of units to meet the density minimums of the zone, a density covenant was recorded to bind the owner to develop according the preliminary plan.

## **COMMUNITY OUTREACH**

The proposed land division went through the standard land use review and approval process. Notice of application was mailed to the applicant, the neighborhood association and property owners located within 300 feet of the site on April 16, 2018. Notice of the application and hearing were posted on the site by the applicant on April 24, 2018.
