- 4. <u>TIMING CONSIDERATIONS</u>: The Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on January 17, 2019 and make a recommendation to the County Council. The Council will ultimately take action on the proposed change.
- 5. <u>DESIRED RESULTS</u>: To brief the Council and to answer any questions before the project goes to hearing.
- IMPACTS (COMMUNITY/FINANCIAL/STAFF/OTHER): Establishment of campus housing as an allowed use in the University District. Currently the University District applies only to WSU-Vancouver.
- 7. <u>POLICY IMPLICATIONS</u>: The action by the Council will allow dormitories to be built in the University District, as an outright permitted use. The development code update will allow WSU-V to proceed with the update of its master plan. A master plan update involves a type III review process, which includes a hearings officer public hearing.
- 8. ISSUES TO BE CONSIDERED: WSU-V is in the process of updating its master plan and their current proposal is to eventually include undergraduate housing on the campus. WSU-V held three open houses in 2018 for public input regarding the university's master plan update and the inclusion of campus housing. Campus housing has been controversial for the neighborhoods bordering WSU-Vancouver.
- **9.** <u>**RECOMMENDED ACTION**</u>: Hold a work session on January 16, 2019 at 11 am and proceed to a public hearing on February 26, 2019.
