REQUESTED ACTION: Approve notice to contractors to advertise for construction bids for the 2018 Preservation Guardrail Improvements project, Capital Road Project No. 381822.

Consent Hearing County Manager

BACKGROUND

This project will improve guardrail for the 2018 hot-mix asphalt overlay project. Road locations for guardrail are detailed on the attached vicinity map.

For the safety of workers and the public, Clark County may temporarily close portions of one travel lane during construction.

To avoid project confusion for bidding, bridge rail has been dropped from the project name, as there will not be any bridge rail in this project.

COUNCIL POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. The project is included in the 2018-2023 Transportation Improvement Program, the 2018 Annual Construction Program (No. 20) and adopted 2017-2018 biennium budget.

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY IMPLICATIONS

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

This project is listed in the adopted 2019-2024 Transportation Improvement Program and adopted 2019 Annual Construction Program. Community outreach for the Transportation Improvement Program included a work session and a hearing with the Clark County Council, presentations to Clark County Planning Commission, Regional Transportation Advisory Committee, and the Development and Engineering Advisory Board, completion of a State Environmental Policy Act review and targeted outreach to neighborhood groups and other stakeholders.

Public Works will provide additional community outreach as needed for road locations where construction will significantly affect drivers and adjacent residents.

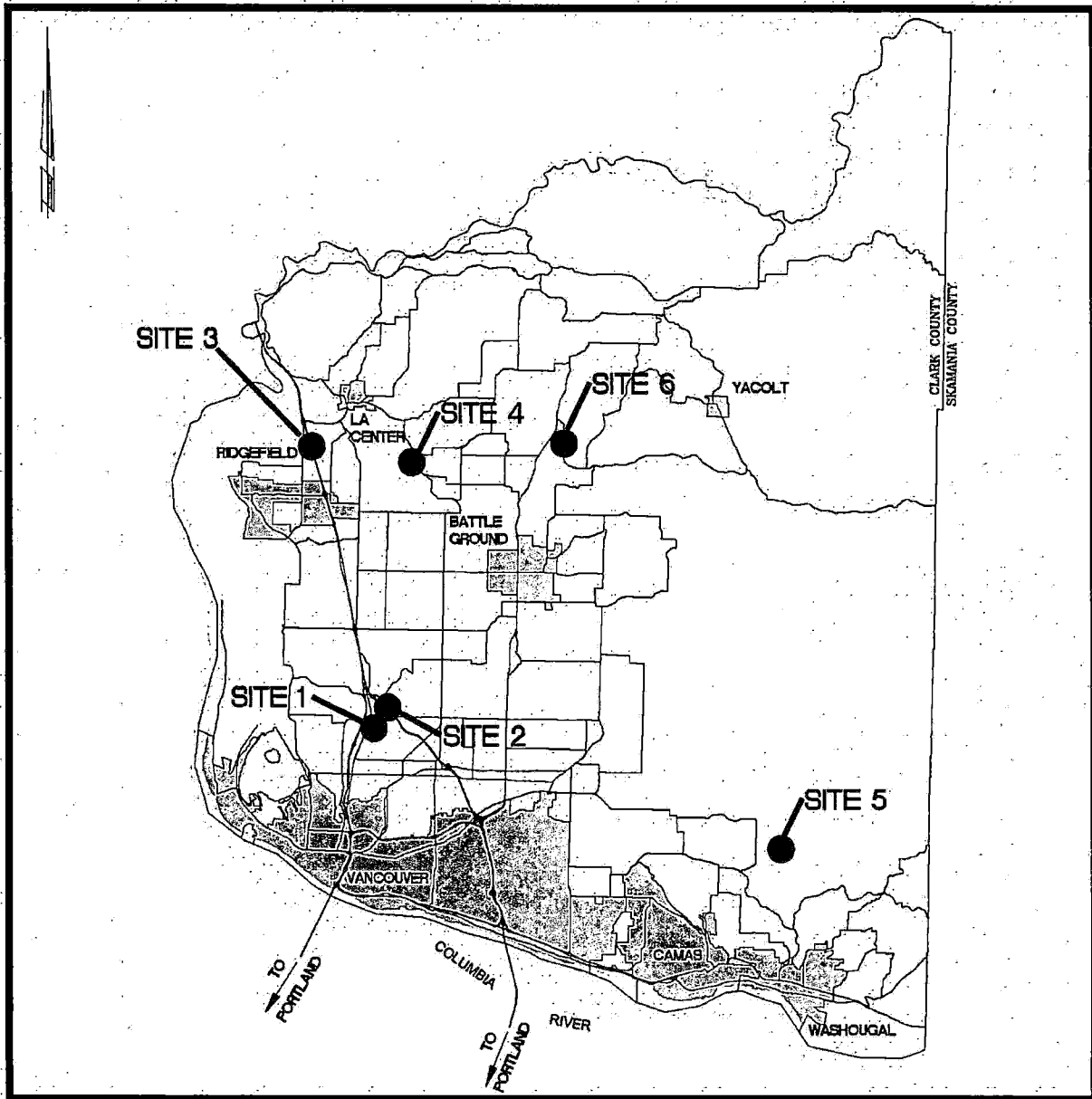

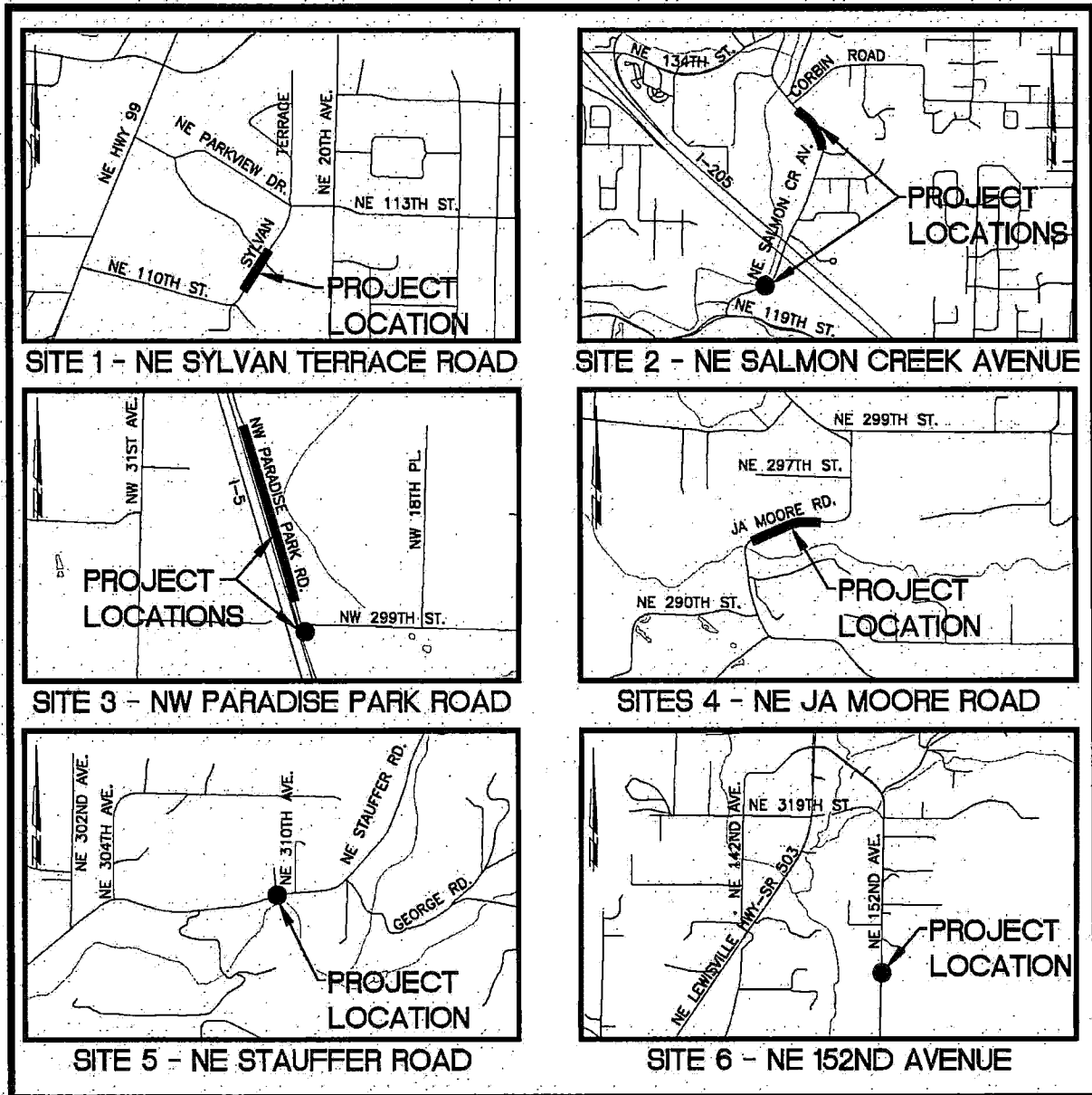

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by Clark County, Washington until **1:50 P.M. on February 12, 2019** for: **CRP No. 381822, 2018 Preservation Guardrail Improvements.**

Sealed bids shall be delivered to the office of Clark County Purchasing, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660 (or P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, WA 98666-5000). Bids delivered to locations other than as indicated above or received after the time indicated above will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, on the same day in the Hearing Room of the Board of County Councilors, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center.

Description of work: Improvement of guardrail at 6 locations throughout Clark County including removing guardrail, raising existing guardrail, and installing new guardrail and associated work.

Primary bid items: Beam Guardrail Type 31, Beam Guardrail Type 31 Non-Flared Terminal, Raising Existing Beam Guardrail, Removing Guardrail, Beam Guardrail Type 31 – 11 Ft Long Post.

Bid documents can be viewed, downloaded, or purchased on the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) website www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Bidders are encouraged to "Register as a Bidder" in order to receive automatic email notification of future addenda and to be placed on the Bidders List. Electronic and paper copies of bid documents are not available from Clark County.

It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to obtain Addenda, if any. Such information may be obtained from the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) web site, www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Clark County accepts no responsibility or liability and will provide no accommodation to bidders who fail to check for addenda and submit inadequate or incomplete bids.

Questions and requests for clarification must be submitted using the electronic "CRP Inquiry Submittal Form" located on the County website, <https://www.clark.wa.gov/general-services/public-works-roads-parks-clean-water-projects>. Responses will be posted on the project's "Bid Inquiry Log".

All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid documents. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the Bidder's company name, project title, project number, bid opening date, and "SEALED BID" clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.



Each bid proposal must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or proposal bond in an amount of at least five percent (5%) of the total bid. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into a contract and furnish a satisfactory contract bond, the bid deposit shall be forfeited to Clark County.

It is Clark County's policy to assure that no person shall on the grounds of race, color, national origin, or sex as provided by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or otherwise be discriminated against under any County sponsored program or activity.
