PRECINCT BOUNDARY CHANGE NOTIFICATION

On March 18, the Clark County Elections Department will mail approximately 20,000 voter registration identification cards to voters. As required by law, each county voter who is moved into a different voting precinct is sent a new card.

State law requires that all voting precincts in Washington contain 1,500 or less registered voters. As a result of this requirement, along with state law requiring precincts to lie completely within or completely outside of a city, 25 new precincts were added and 47 existing precinct boundary lines were adjusted.

All of these changes have now been completed and the new registration cards will be sent to voters along with a letter explaining the reason for the new card.
