The meeting should run about 90 minutes unless something special needs to be addressed. We will have three (3) guest speakers:

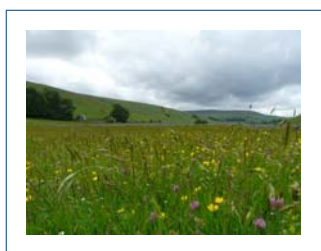
- 1) Gordon Euler – Update on the rural land bank and the Langler Dairy land

### Special Topics of Interest

- 1) Battle Ground is planning on revising their public sewer system plans. They should not directly affect the MGNA but stay tuned
- 2) Battle Ground is trying to raise money to fix streets. They need about \$15 million to catch up. They are going to ask the voters to approve an increase in the sales tax within the city limits from 8.4% to 8.6%. For those of you who shop in town that may affect you.
- 3) School Bonds – The Battle Ground School District may be coming to the voters in 2016 with a request for money to update and build schools. We'll keep you informed so stay tuned.
