### Clark County Public Works Expects to Begin Work this year on a Major Infrastructure

The project will extend, widen and improve Northeast 10th Avenue, including building a new bridge.

The current schedule, which is subsequent to change, calls for the county to open construction bids from private contractors in late February or early March and award a contract two weeks later. Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin May 1 and wrap up by fall 2018.
