**Proposed Cell Tower Hits Close to Home** 

Salmon Creek residents near a proposed cellular phone tower have received notice of environmental impact hearings for the proposed site. The construction is proposed for a tower 130 foot tower and ground equipment about 800 feet south of 151st Street across from NW 29th Ct.

The project name is POR Bliss. If you have received a notice of the application and the environmental hearing you are welcome to make comment to the county. Terri Brooks is listed at the staff contact and can be reached at 360-397-2375 x 4885 or Terri.brooks@clark.wa.gov. There is also a new Facebook group that you may join to share information and discuss this project with your neighbors, Bliss Rd Cell Phone Tower.

At this time the application is on hold, but as of last report it is expected to move forward at a later date. This gives time for those who may be affected by this project to contact the county and share their concerns.
