1. Madeleine called the meeting to order. Meeting minutes will be recorded and transcribed from now on. Call to approve meeting notes from September. Ken made a correction on first page; the Forum on Transportation is being hosted by the State Legislature, not WSDOT. A motion was entered to approve the meeting notes as amended, seconded and unanimously approved.

 - Chuck will work on Goal #3
 - An agreement was reached to revise the goals and bring them back to the group in November.

 - Laurie presented the Memoranda to the group.
 - Engineering memo, Page 2, "Add signage per MUTCD".
 - Public Health memo, Termination – add language regarding crossings.
 - Laurie will revise memoranda and bring revised memoranda back before the group in November for approval.

- c. 99th Street and Highway 99
 - Ellen presented her issue with 99th Street at Highway 99.
 - The group agreed to form a group to address this issue. Group to be Ellen, Trish, Laurel and Chuck.

3. New Business

- a. BPAC applicant selection committee
 - Dan, Margaret and Madeleine said they would like to be on the sub-committee for recommending two new members for the BPAC committee to the BOCC.
 - Madeleine will email BPAC to ask if anyone else is interested in joining this sub-committee.

 - SR502 widening between 10th Avenue and Battle Ground has been delayed to 2014.
 - I-205/Salmon Creek: moving along with construction.

- Todd Bachman: Presented problems with the Ellen Davis Trail. The group told him to take issues to Vancouver-Clark Parks Department and the City of Vancouver.
