Bike Clark County and Vancouver Bike Club will host a ride to North Portland and around Portland International Raceway (PIR) to view the Winter Wonderland Lights. This event is for bikes only; no motorized vehicles will be allowed on the PIR grounds.

The **Clark Communities Bike and Pedestrian Advisory Committee** will hand out bike lights to participants who do not already have them. Light refreshments are included.

The ride begins promptly at 6:30 p.m. and will be as an organized group. PIR closes at 9:30 p.m.

## Ride Details:

Distance round trip: Less than 13 miles

Terrain: Flat other than the bridge

Pace: Friendly, social, group ride, nobody left behind

Helmets: Required

White front light: Required

Rear red light/reflector: Required

Warm clothing! Night riding can be chilly. Consider a wind breaker over warm layers. Protect your head and hands with a thin cap or ear band under your helmet and gloves. If you're new to riding, check your air, brakes, chain and cranks before leaving home.
