### **I. Roll Call, Approval of Minutes**

Meeting was called to order by Don Ebbeson. Rem Wilson made a motion to approve the February 5, 2015 and March 5, 2015 minutes as written. Stephen Schrag seconded the motion. Motion passed.

#### **County Public Health**

Joe Laxson reported that going forward, Chuck Harman will be attending SWAC meetings on behalf of Public Health. Chuck Harman introduced himself and provided some of his background.

#### **County Environmental Services – Peter DuBois**

Pete discussed some upcoming events and reported that CPG application has been accepted by Ecology and the details are being finalized. Pete gave an update on the Solid Waste Management Plan and the progress of the Interlocal agreements. Pete reported that the single-family recycling study will be underway later this month.

#### **Waste Connections – Scott Campbell**

Scott reported that spring clean-up coupons have gone out to residential customers, and if a customer opts for an electronic bill, they can request a coupon by calling customer service. Scott discussed recycling electronics in Clark County and the new Light Recycle Washington program.

### **III. Discussion regarding excusing Brandon Vick**

Don Ebbeson stated that Brandon Vick has not been attending SWAC meetings due to the State Legislature being in session. Don spoke with him and Brandon stated that he would like to remain on the commission. Don made a motion to excuse Brandon from SWAC while the Legislature is in session. Rules regarding attendance and making an exception were read and discussed by commission members. It was decided that a letter be drafted and sent to all members and the vote be shelved until the next meeting.
