b.	Recruitment Updates: Sergeant Fred Neiman shared information with the commission about some recent movie theater advertising, as well as radio advertising that the sheriff's office is putting out there. The movie theater ads will be active from 12/15/19 to 1/15/2020. Also CCSO now has an Instagram account. Reminder that Sgt Neiman will be retiring effective January 30. He started as a reserve deputy with CCSO in 1980 and will have 31 years and 7 months of service.
	Secretary Harrington Smith shared that interviews for the Jail Industries Manager will take place on December 18, and there will be a request for a special meeting soon after that for list certification. In addition there will be an uptick in number of backgrounds as about 2 dozen candidates will be sent the link to star their background profiles.
	Keely Warren shared with the group that the Sheriff's Office hired 33 new employees in 2019.
