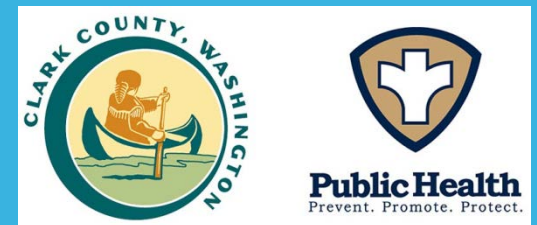

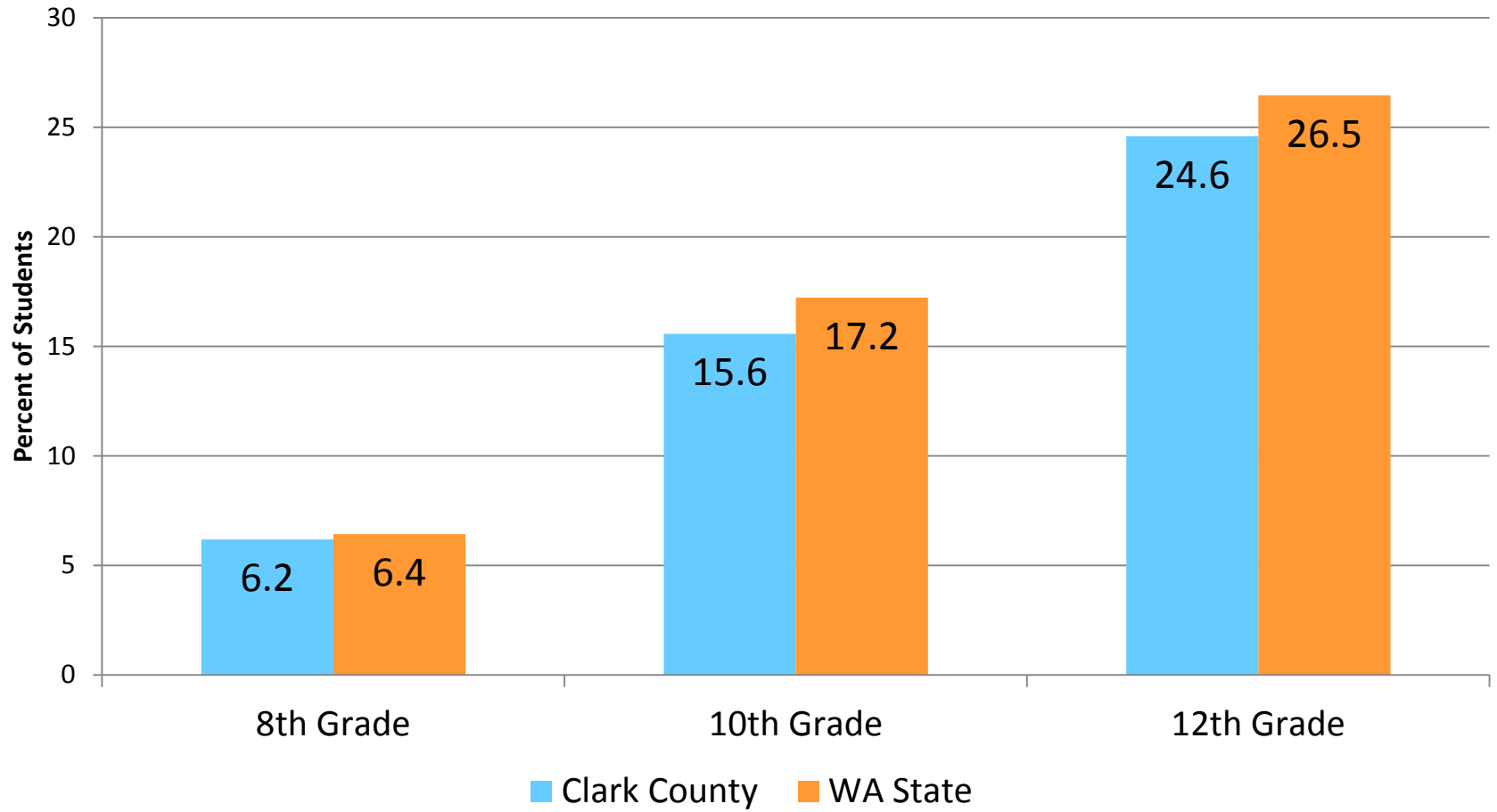
Washington State Healthy Youth Survey



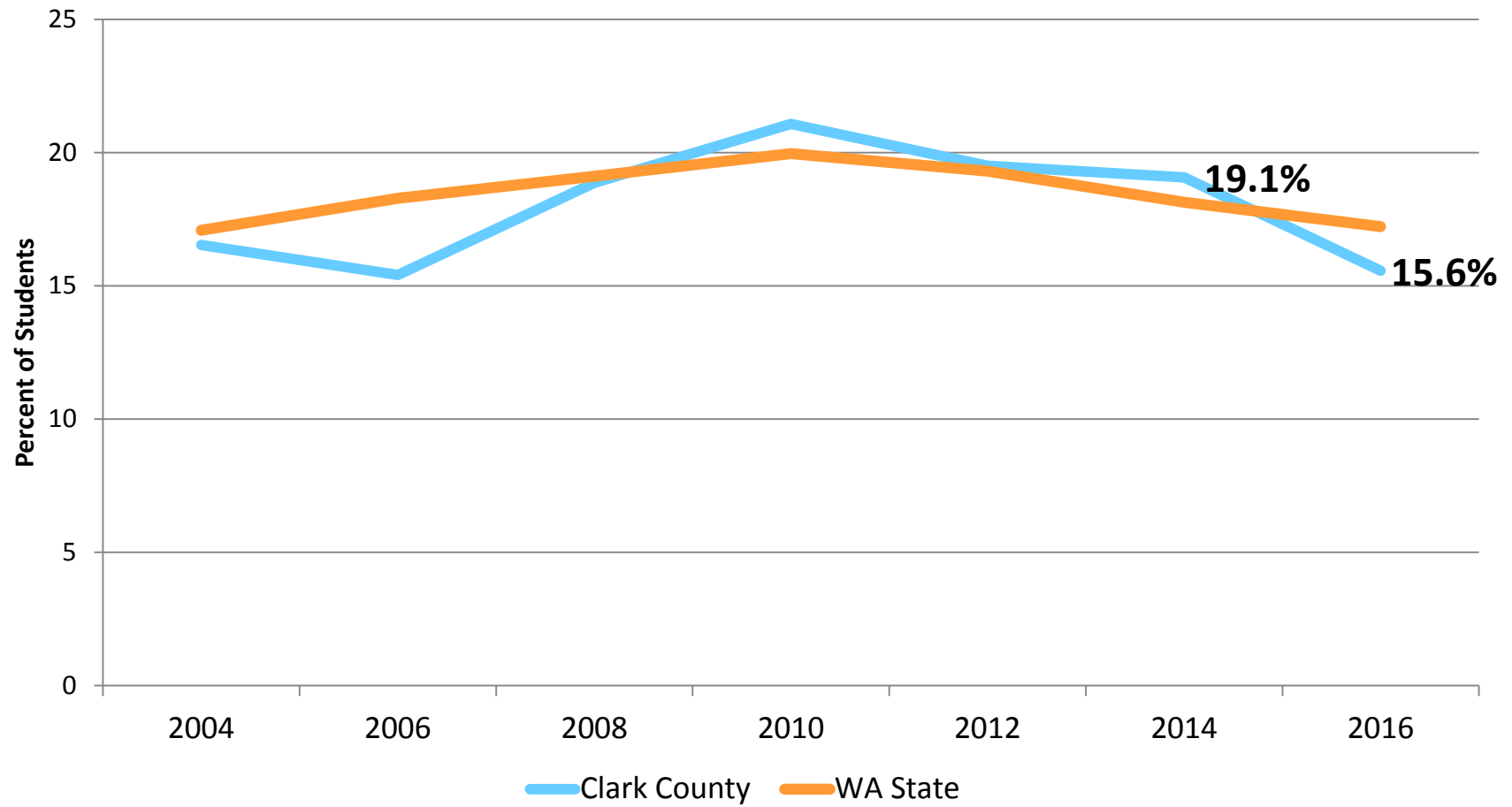
- Statewide survey for 6th, 8th, 10th & 12th graders, conducted every 2 years
- Focuses on substance use, mental health, nutrition & physical activity, and school climate & safety.
- Last survey was conducted in the Fall of 2016
 - Over 230,000 students from all 39 counties participated
 - Over 13,000 students from Clark County
- 2016 data were released in March 2017
- Collaborative effort between school districts, communities, and the state.



Current (last 30 days) Marijuana Use, 2016

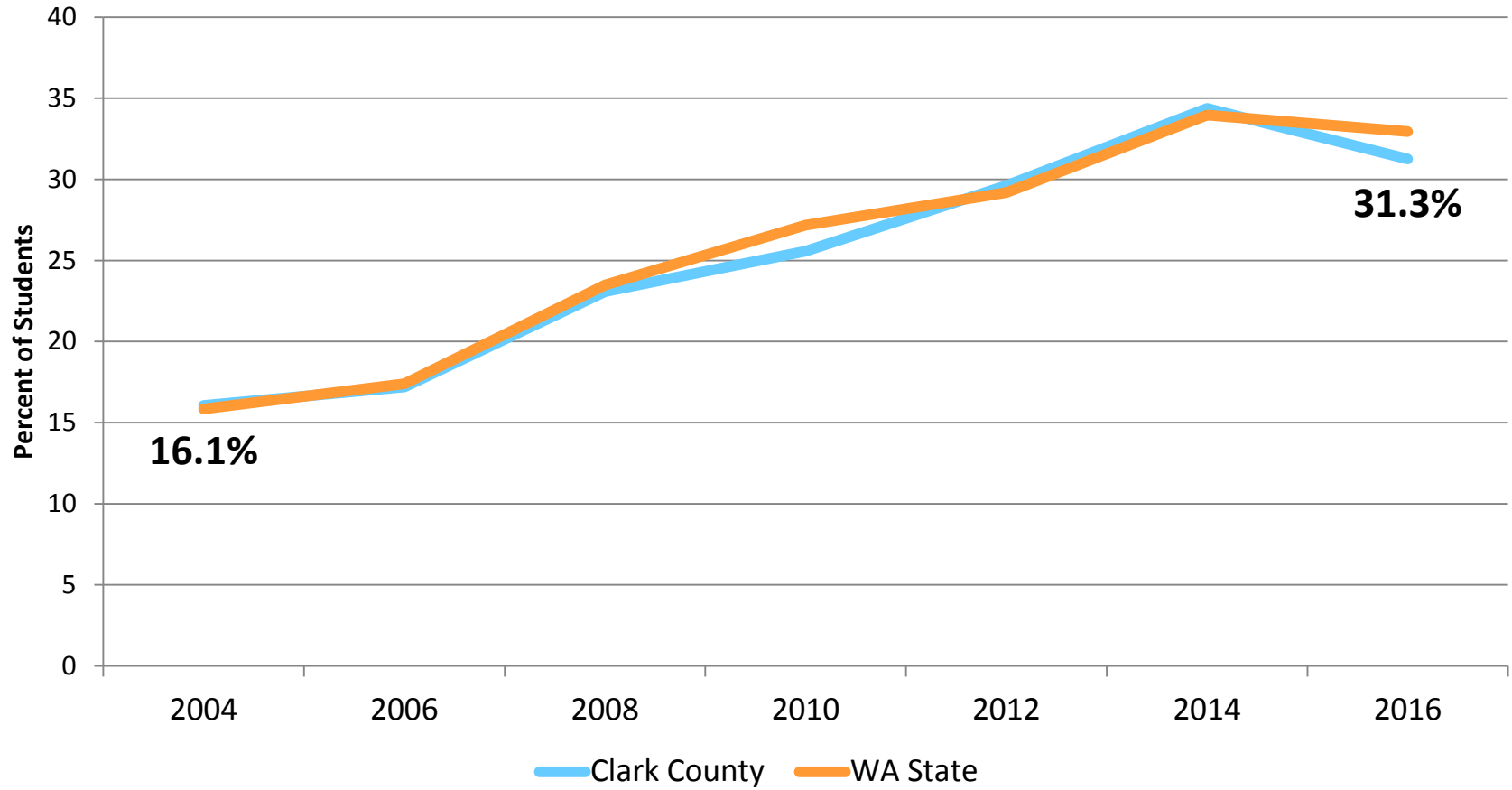


Current Marijuana Use Among 10th Graders in Clark County & Washington State, 2004-2016



Perception of Harm from Marijuana

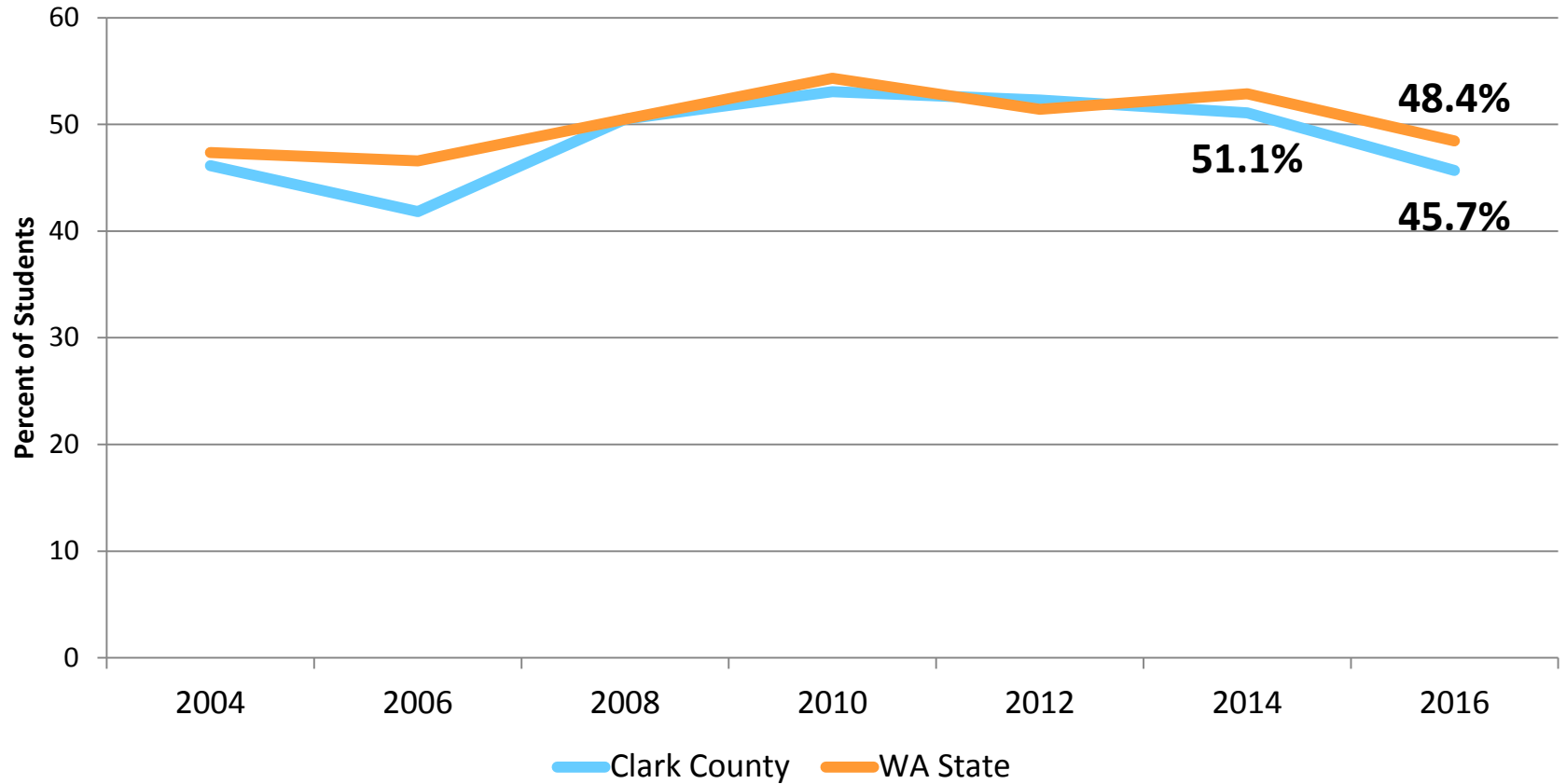
Percentage of 10th Graders Who Perceive of No or Low Risk of Harm From Regular* Marijuana Use, 2004-2016



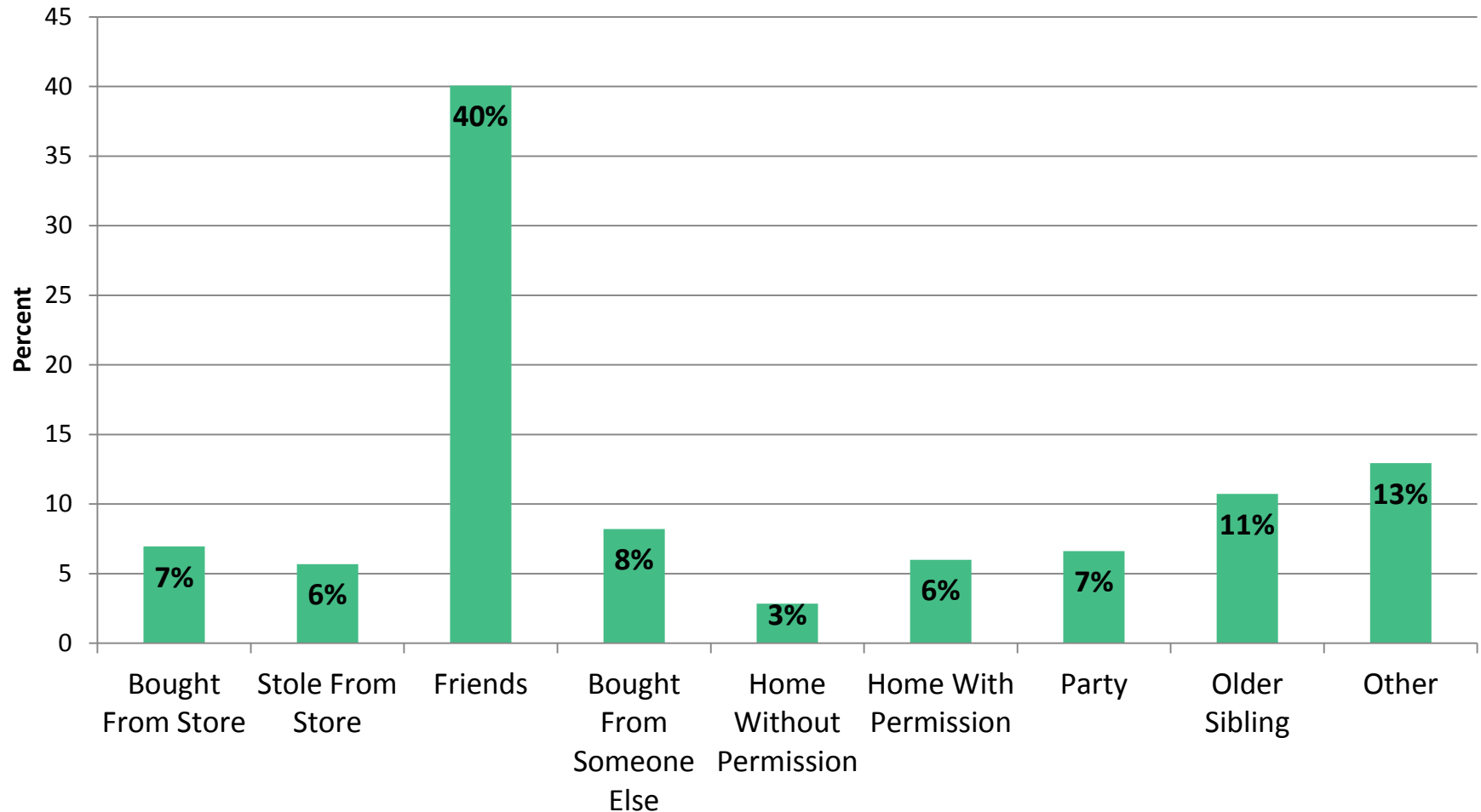
*Regular marijuana use is defined as using marijuana at least once or twice a week.

Ease of Access to Marijuana

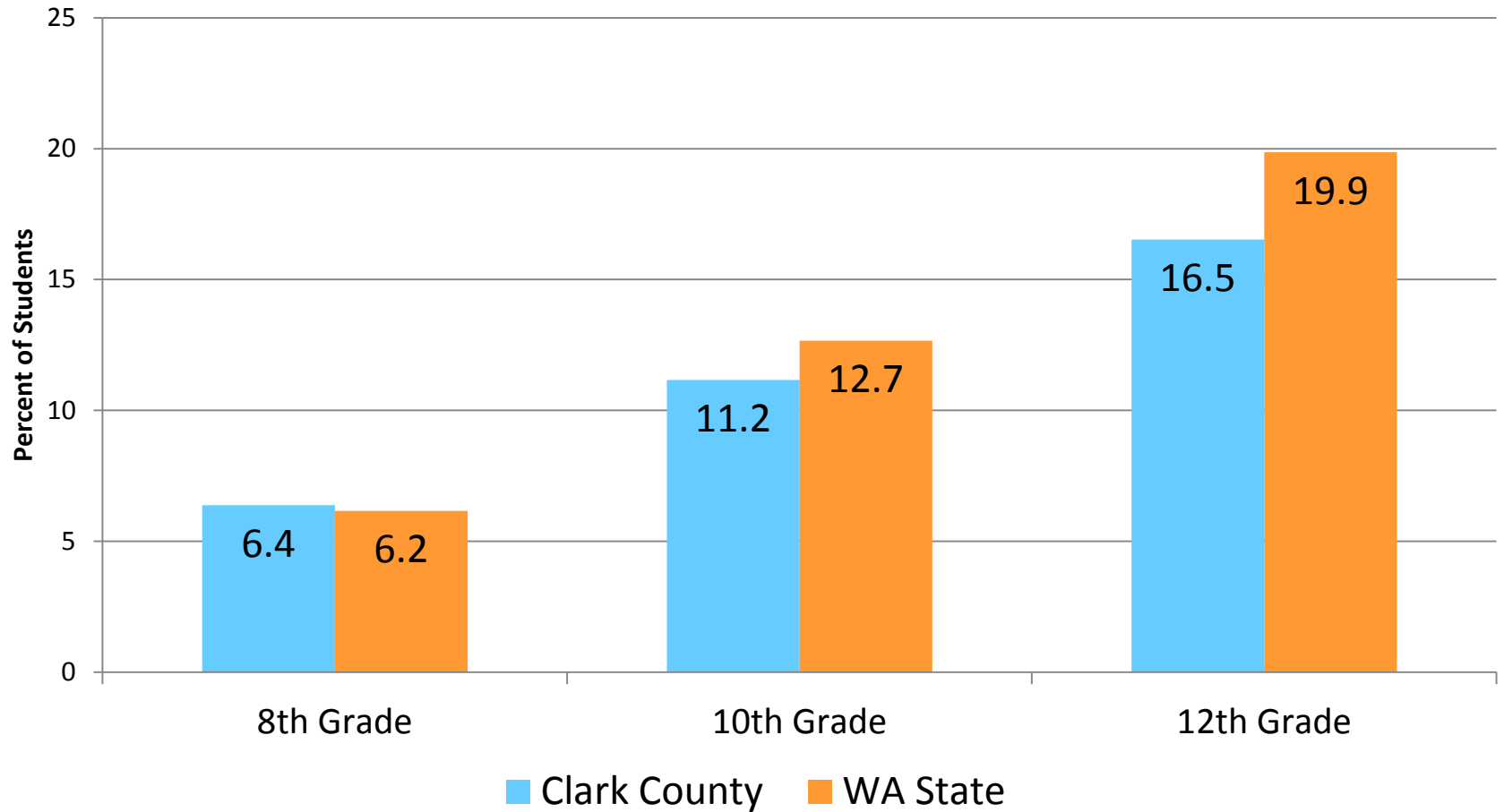
Percentage of 10th Graders Who Reported Very Easy or Sort of Easy Access to Marijuana, 2004-2016



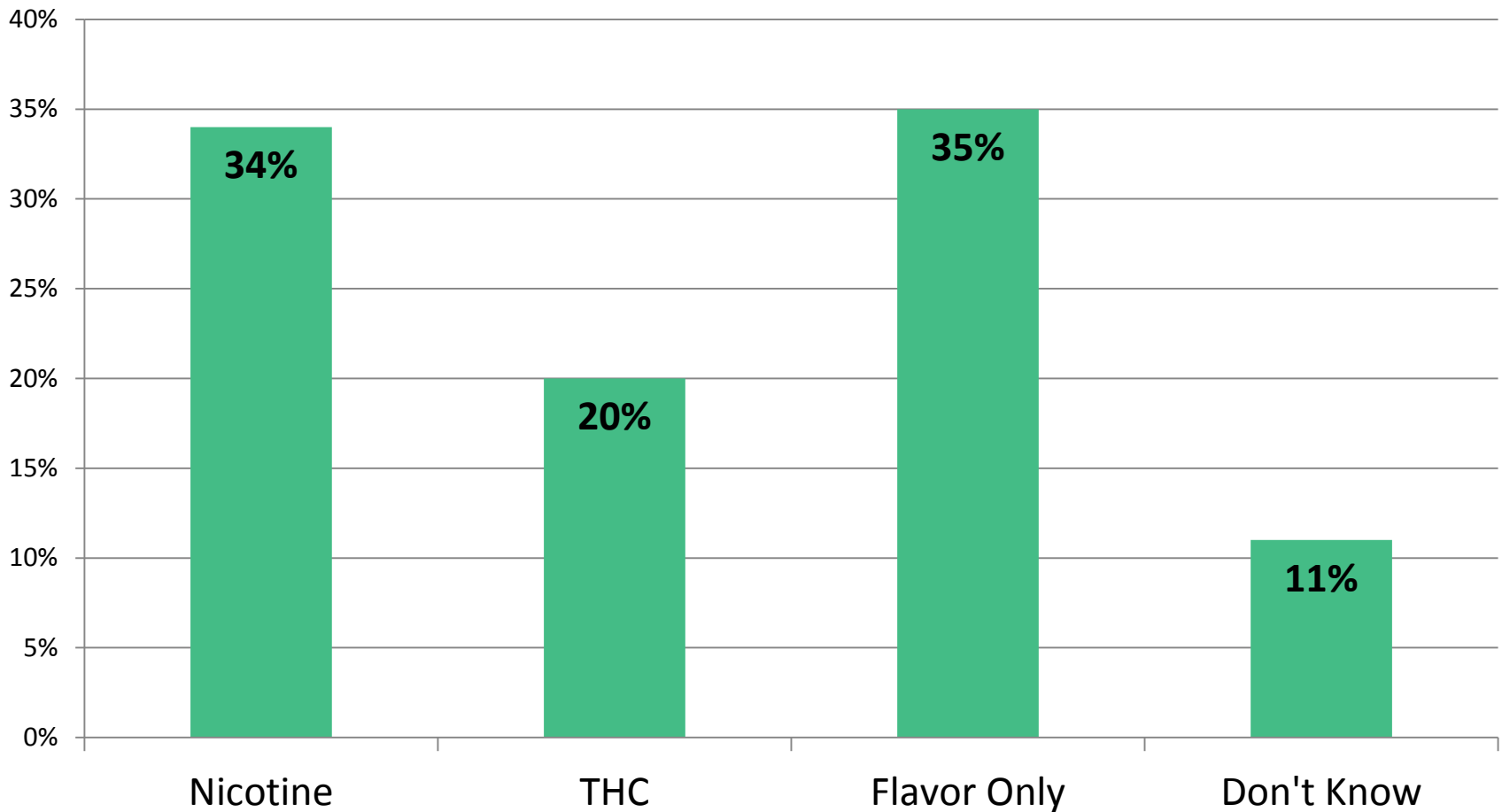
Of 2016 Clark County 10th graders who currently used marijuana, where did they get their marijuana?



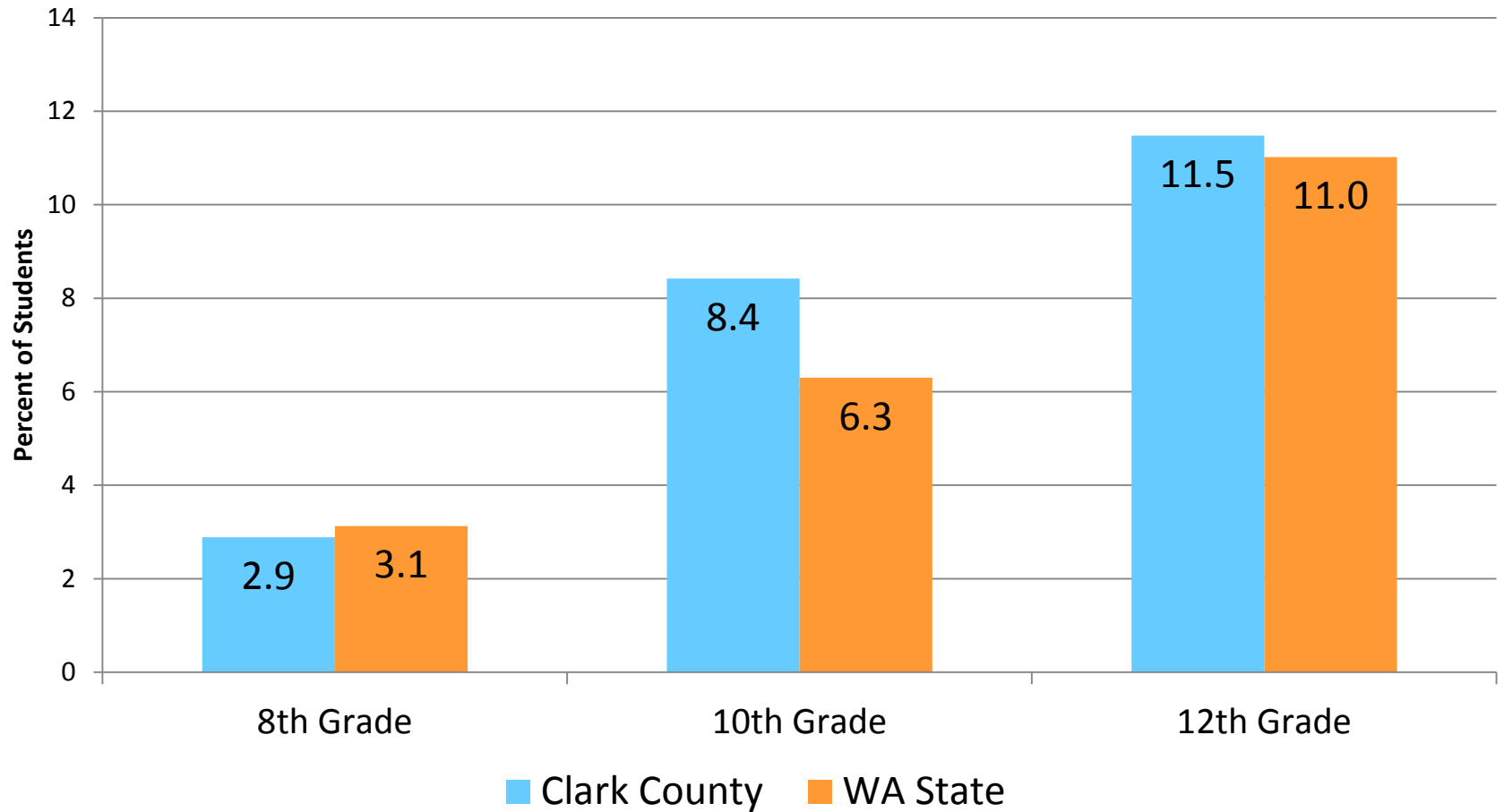
Current (last 30 days) E-Cigarette/Vape Pen Use, 2016



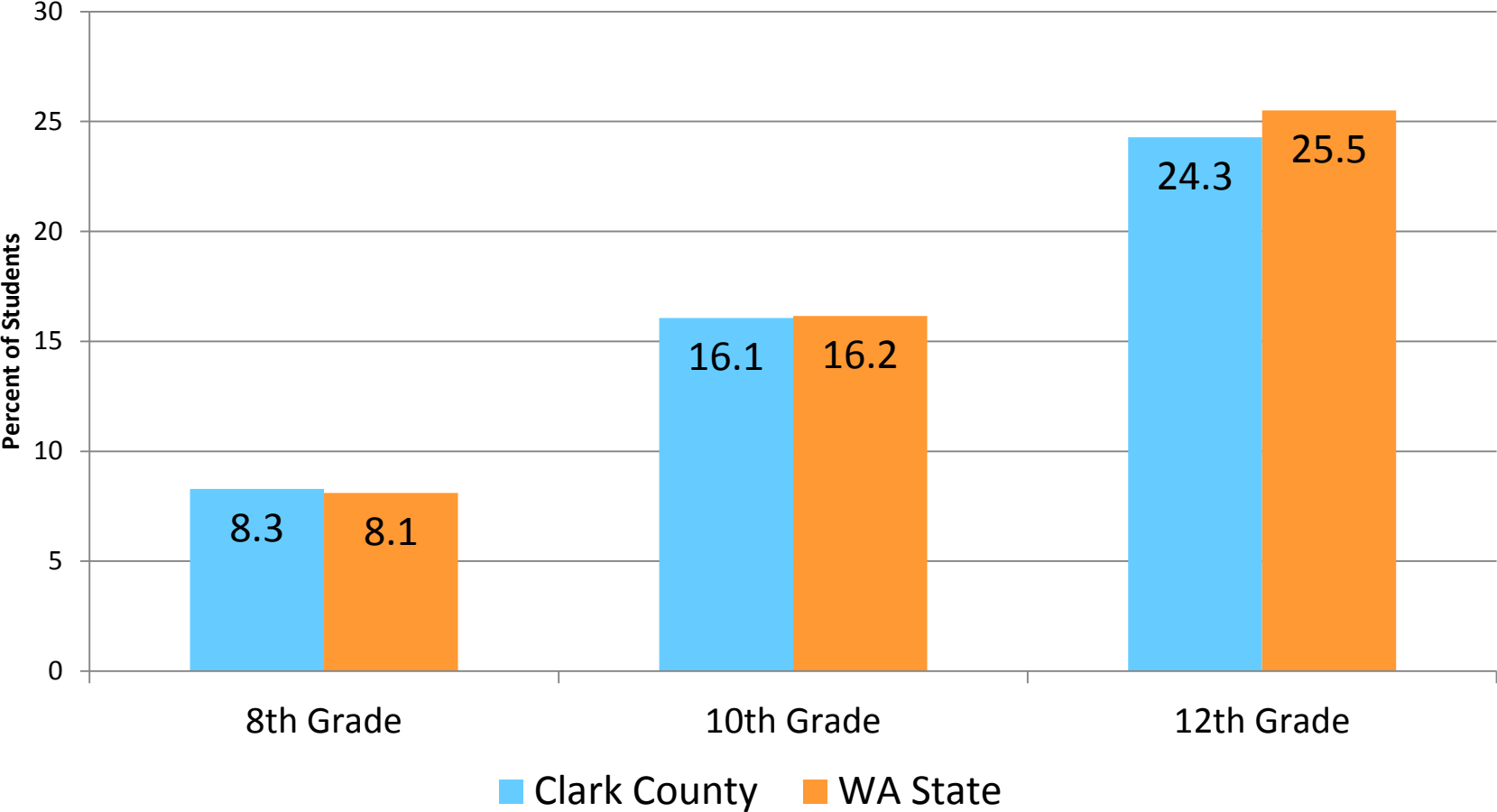
Of 2016 Clark County 10th graders who currently used e-cigarettes/vape pens, what did they vape?



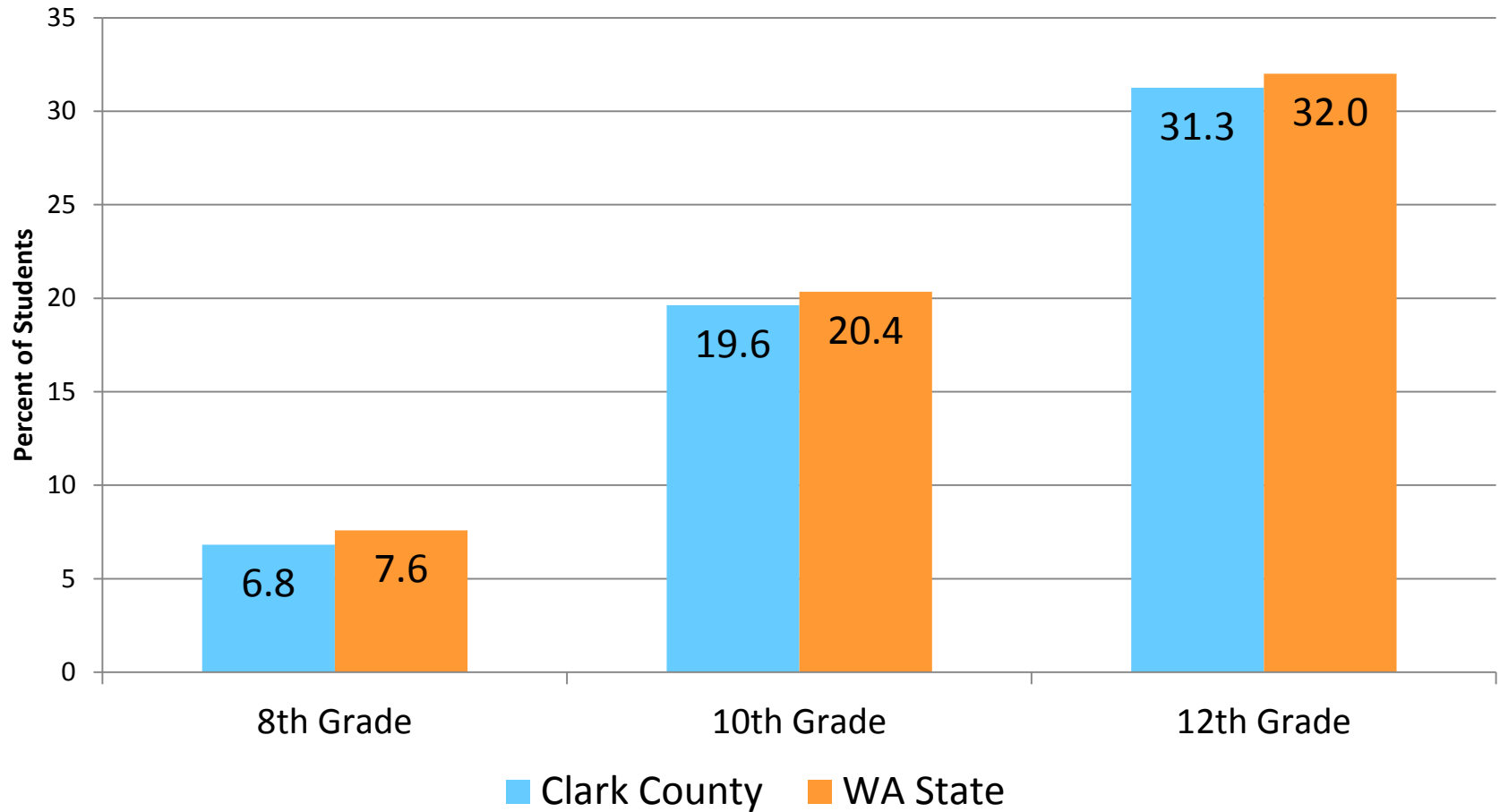
Current (last 30 days) Cigarette Use, 2016



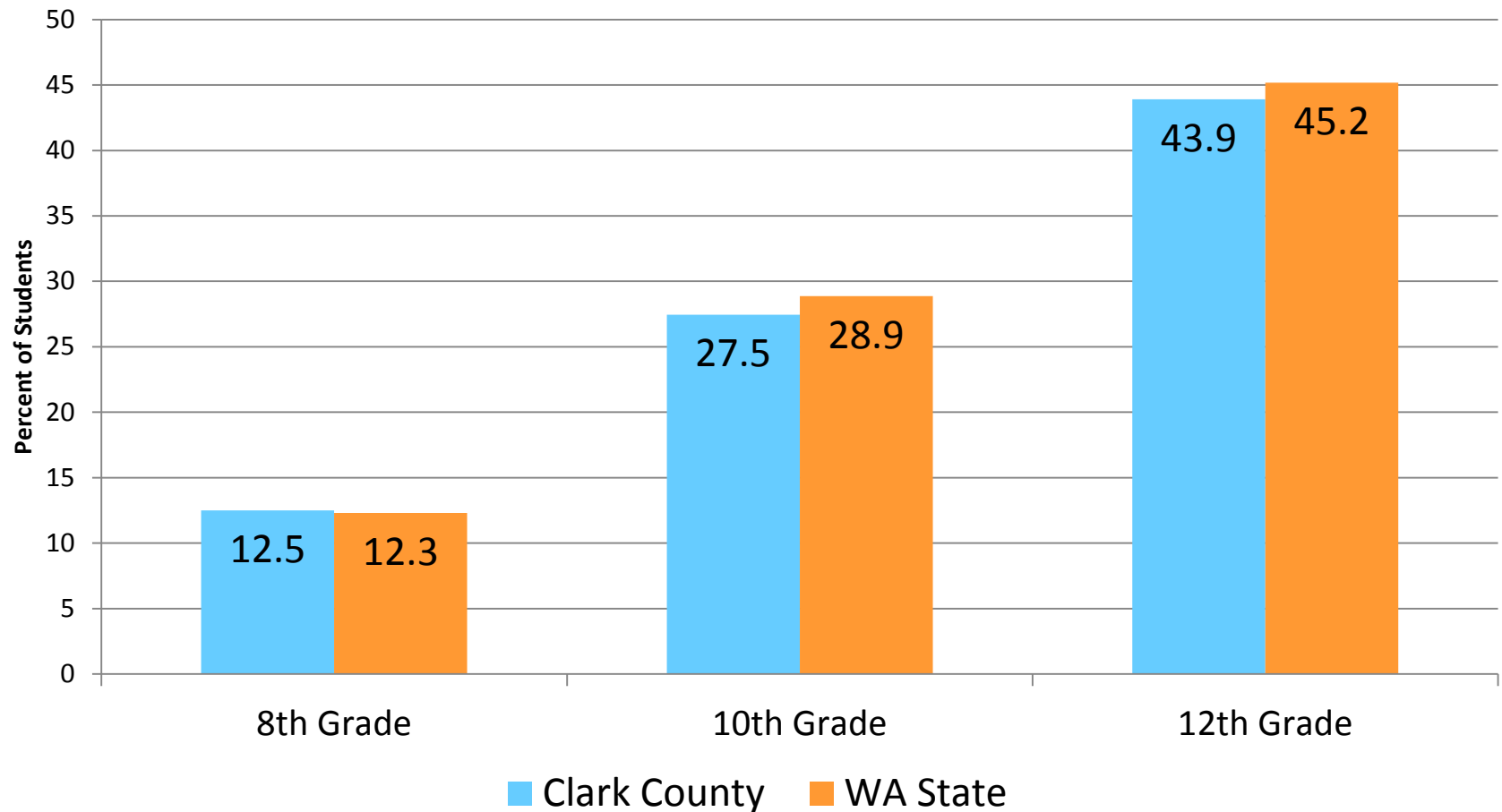
Current (last 30 days) Use of Any Tobacco Product, 2016

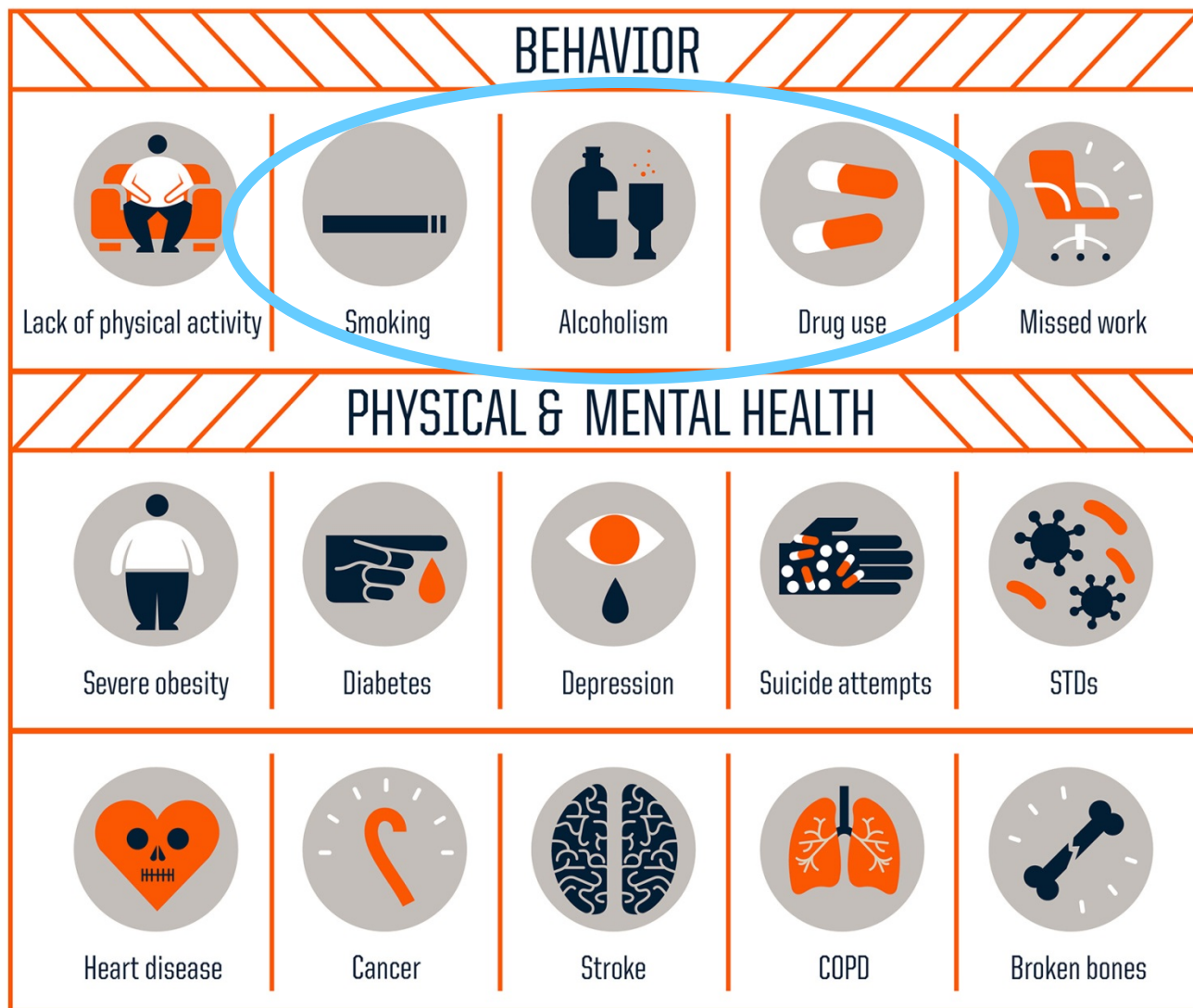

ACEs Lead to Poor Health Behaviors & Outcomes



27.5% of all Clark County 10th graders used alcohol, marijuana and/or regular/e-cigarettes in the past month.

21% of Clark County 10th graders have been **physically abused**.

43% of **physically abused** 10th graders use alcohol, marijuana and/or reg/e-cigarettes.

16% of Clark County 10th graders have been **sexually abused**.

46% of **sexually abused** 10th graders use alcohol, marijuana and/or reg/e-cigarettes.

14% of Clark County 10th graders are **emotionally abused at home**.

55% of **emotionally abused** 10th graders use alcohol, marijuana and/or reg/e-cigarettes.

6% of Clark County 10th graders experienced **dating violence**.

63% of 10th graders experiencing **dating violence** use alcohol, marijuana and/or reg/e-cigarettes.

22% of Clark County 10th graders have **witnessed physical abuse among adults**.

47% of 10th graders who have **witnessed violence** use alcohol, marijuana and /or reg/e-cigarettes.

27.5% of all Clark County 10th graders used alcohol, marijuana and/or regular/e-cigarettes in the past month.

19% of Clark County 10th graders experience **high anxiety**.

37% of 10th graders with **anxiety** use alcohol, marijuana and/or reg/e-cigarettes.

35% of Clark County 10th graders are **depressed**.

43% of **depressed** 10th graders use alcohol marijuana and/or reg/e-cigarettes.

20% of Clark County 10th graders have **considered suicide**.

47% of 10th graders **considering suicide** use alcohol, marijuana and/or reg/e-cigarettes.

9% of Clark County 10th graders have **attempted suicide**.

56% of 10th graders who have **attempted suicide** use alcohol, marijuana and/or reg/e-cigarettes.

27.5% of all Clark County 10th graders used alcohol, marijuana and/or regular/e-cigarettes in the past month.

33% of Clark County 10th graders are at high risk for **poor family management**.

49% of 10th graders at high risk of **poor family management** use alcohol, marijuana and/or cigarettes.

6% of Clark County 10th graders experience **housing insecurity**.

45% of 10th graders who experience **housing insecurity** use alcohol, marijuana and/or reg/e-cigarettes.

12% of Clark County 10th graders experience **food insecurity**.

41% of 10th graders who experience **food insecurity** use alcohol, marijuana and/or reg/e-cigarettes.

5% of Clark County 10th graders are **involved in a gang**.

57% of 10th graders who are **involved in a gang** use alcohol, marijuana and/or reg/e-cigarettes.
