Review the process of today's meeting	Hayley	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hayley shared with the group her process of how she prepared and gathered the information she needed to prepare her for the activity. After interviewing a few members, attending past meeting, Hayley compiled this information into three bucket areas.</li> </ul> <p>The three bucket areas are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Networking (ex: monthly coalition meeting, the Big Latch, Facebook)</li> <li>Training (ex: Breastfeeding Provider training 2019)</li> <li>Resource Hub (ex: Resource Guide, Vancouver Chamber of Commerce)</li> </ul>	
Identify areas of work and potential action plan	Hayley	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Through a facilitated activity, and putting yourself in the "anything is possible" mindset, on sticky notes, participants will write down answers to 2 of the following questions:</li> </ul> <p><b>1. What are actions the coalition can take in the <u>next year</u> in this strategy bucket to help us achieve our mission?</b></p> <p><b>2. What are actions the coalition can take in the <u>next 3 years</u> to help us achieve our mission?</b></p> <p>Participants posted their answers on the wall in the 3 different bucket areas. The answers were also posted under the 1 year or 3 year timeline. Hayley then grouped the items that were alike.</p>	

Dot Voting	Hayley	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There were two things participants voted on <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ With the 4 DARK blue dots, participants indicated which action(s) they were most excited about CCBC working on.</li> <li>➤ With you 4 LIGHT blue dots, participants indicated which action(s) they feel is the most realistic to accomplish given our current capacity.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	
Next Steps		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hayley will create a draft strategy map.</li> <li>• Next month's meeting, we will review the strategy map and needed modifications</li> <li>• We will discuss who/how we will work on these strategies, ideally by growing our coalition (and how we might do this)</li> </ul>
