To Join:

The Parent MUST:

1. Be a Clark County legal resident age 18 or older
2. Admit to having a substance abuse problem and want treatment
3. Volunteer for the program and agree to the terms
4. Be seeking custody of child(ren)
5. Join within 6 months of Dependency being filed.
Anything beyond will be considered case-by-case

The Parent CANNOT have:

- * Any serious violent/sex offenses in criminal history
- * Any other pending charges/outstanding warrants resulting in **30+** days of jail
- * Used a firearm in the commission of any crime
- * Active Domestic Violence charges, No Contact Orders will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis
- * Severe mental health / cognitive issues that would prevent ability to understand the program and /or refuse services


